

Pastor's Desk

As we all settle in to our routines during these first weeks of September, it's good to have a reminder from this week's Gospel about the fact that even when we turn our back on God, there is always a way back, always an opportunity for a new beginning. The three stories that Jesus tells in the Gospel are all about how merciful God is and how he longs for his people to be saved. Jesus is trying to make the Pharisees and scribes understand that God doesn't want it to come down to judgment. God wants reconciliation with everyone. In his stories he paints a picture of a shepherd who has a hundred sheep, but leaves the 99 safe ones gathered together to find just one who is lost. The same is true for the woman who has lost one of her ten coins. She goes out of her way looking high and low for it. The Pharisees and scribes see the sinners as disposable, not even worth another's time, but Jesus reminds them that the God who they claim to be serving is passionate about the lost. God actively seeks us when we turn our back on our relationship with him. That's what these readings are trying to convey. We don't have to beg for God's love or forgiveness. It's a gift. God gives it freely. ~ Fr. Bob

Mass at the Lake


Sunday September 18th at 10:30AM




2022-23 Faith Formation Registration Now Open

Reclaim Our Vote Postcard Campaign

This fall, Our Lady of Sorrows is once again supporting the Center for Common Ground, a 501(c)(3) organization, in its non-partisan Reclaim Our Vote campaign. Volunteers are needed to write postcards to voters in states with histories of voter suppression informing these voters about when and where they can exercise their right to vote in our upcoming elections.

To sign up to help go to https://tinyurl.com/3wzvbhuh. Volunteers will receive a packet containing the names and addresses of 30 voters, as well as a script, pens, postcards, and labels containing important voting information. You will be notified by email when your packet is ready for pickup (approximately September 18). Completed postcards should be returned to the Bullock Center by Sunday, October 15. We will add

stamps and mail the postcards for you.

Volunteers are asked to donate \$16 per packet to cover the cost of supplies (including stamps), but a donation is not required. Donations can be made by check, in cash or via PayPal.
