



### Pastor's Desk

Ready or not, next Sunday is Palm Sunday which will begin our Holy Week services. The readings today are trying to prepare us for Holy Week, as Jesus reveals that he is the resurrection and the life. The readings for this fifth Sunday of Lent have as their themes death which leads to new life, despair giving way to hope, and new life rising up from the ashes. At the center of all this talk about hope and new life is Jesus. For the past few weeks, John's Gospel has Jesus trying to reveal who he is to those in need of healing. This week we are treated to the truth about Jesus' power over death. His friend dies, and he comes to the tomb and weeps. I don't think he is weeping for Lazarus, because he knows what he has come to do. I think he weeps for all those standing around who don't yet understand that **he is** the resurrection and that **he is** the promised Messiah, who restores eternal life to all the children of God. That is our hope and our joy as we prepare to celebrate the paschal mystery.




### Continental Breakfast Item Donations Needed for MainSpring House


