





Dear OLOS Community,

I am writing today with the news of my intention to leave my position on the OLOS staff this coming summer.

When I was hired for the position of Youth Ministry Coordinator in 2015, I could not have imagined the changes that the next eight years would have for me at OLOS and in life more broadly, nor the myriad of ways that being a part of the OLOS community would touch, inspire, and nourish me. As I look back on my shifts in role, the changes in staff, pastoral, and volunteer leadership over the years, and the circumstances of the wider world, I am humbled and grateful to have served, learned, and grown within this very special community.

As I transition out of my position at OLOS, the staff will be hiring a new Coordinator of Faith Formation to work alongside Monica LaFond in the Office of Faith Formation. 
Care Kit Collection


