

#### **Breakfast Donations for Mainspring House**



### Consider Serving as a Faith Formation Volunteer

Faith Formation volunteers help young people come to know Christ and the riches of our faith by teaching weekly PreK-Grade 5 Faith Formation Classes or facilitating a small group in the Middle School or Confirmation program

In order to serve as a Catechist, you must:

- Be available Sunday mornings from 9:45 until 10:45 am
- Be comfortable and able to communicate effectively with the age group that you teach
- Prepare lessons (based on lesson plans provided within our *Blest Are We* curriculum)
- Attend a catechist training session in the fall

An **Assistant Catechist** helps the catechist in their work by:

- Helping children who require special assistance
- · Taking attendance
- Accompanying children to the restroom
- Monitoring children until the catechist arrives
- Substitute teaching if catechist is absent
- Other duties as negotiated with the catechist

Hall Monitors are available during PreK-Grade 5 classes to help as need arise; Substitute Catechists are "on call" to fill in when Catechists are away or sick.

<u>Middle School Facilitators</u> assist the middle school faith formation teacher and must:

- Commit to serving in the Sunday night program (which meets once a month from 5-6:30 pm) or (if needed) the Tuesday night program (which meets once a month from 7-8:30 pm)
- Lead small group discussions and small group activities throughout the session
- Be a positive adult presence throughout the session and help with other needs as they may arise

<u>Confirmation Facilitators</u> lead small groups within the Confirmation program and must:

- Commit to serving one Thursday night a month from 7-8:30 pm
- Lead approximately two small group discussions/activities per class (small group discussion prompts and activity instructions are provided)
- Be a positive adult presence throughout the class and help create a safe and welcoming space

Training and on-going support are provided for all of our Faith Formation volunteers. All volunteers must comply with Archdiocesan Child Safety and Protection requirements, including: signing a Code of Conduct, attending a Protecting God's Children training session, and completing a CORI form.

# Making a Difference

#### **Ignatian Volunteer Corps**

IVC New England is very busy right now welcoming volunteer applications for 2022-2023. We are actively involved in interviewing and placing applicants for our September start-up, but many openings remain unfilled.

Our 15th year assisting local nonprofit agencies begins September 7. Now is the time to apply! **John Walsh** (left) is taking a break this year from his favorite afternoon activity at **Sister Mary Hart After School Program** in Roxbury (MA), for example. We need someone to fill his very big shoes! Please spread the word to women and men, 50 years of age or better, interested in a September to June year of service and spirituality. Tell them to contact us at **newengland@ivcusa.org** for more information or an application. Click **here** for today's listing of openings.

Education is perhaps our most pressing need. We have a variety of school openings in varied locations and settings: **Epiphany School** in Dorchester is looking for Early Learning Center volunteers. In Jamaica Plain, the **Raphael Hernandez School** needs support and enrichment volunteers. Shrewsbury's **Gateways Academy** seeks teachers, teacher's aides, and after-school volunteers for its exciting new educational effort. **Nurtury Early Education** has a variety of openings in Boston and Cambridge.

Elders have been hit hard by the pandemic and inflation. At **Ethos** in Jamaica Plain, a mental health outreach worker is needed to help senior homeowners stay safe in their homes. **FriendshipWorks** in Boston asks us for someone to support its friendly visiting program in Newton and other neighborhoods. **Springwell**, in Waltham, needs food delivery drivers in the greater Boston area.

For those with an interest in serving immigrants and newcomers to the US, check out Catholic Charities Refugee and Immigrant Services in Boston and its need for someone to coordinate inkind donations, or work in its cultural coordination program. Help with volunteer coordination at International Institute of New England or with guest services at Rian Immigrant Center. Both programs are in downtown Boston. Dorcas International Institute of Rhode Island asks for a clothing collaborative coordinator and education classroom aides. We expect to hear soon from Ascentria Care Alliance in Worcester about its need for volunteer assistance.

Many specialized positions exist, too. **Haley House** (Boston) needs marketing and communications help. **Pernet Family Health** (Worcester) asks for administrative and development assistance, holiday program help, or maintenance skills. **Genesis Center** in Providence has an opening for a medical instructor, or for a marketing or development volunteer. **Bread for the World**, in Worcester County needs a church organizer (Worcester). **Abby's House** (Worcester) seeks overnight shelter volunteers. **Project Hope** (Roxbury) has multiple opportunities.

These are some, but not all of our needs and they change often. Again, check out our website or contact us directly for an up-to-date listing of openings.


