

#### Pastor's Note

Dear parishioners and friends of Our Lady's,

Happy Advent and Merry Christmas

"Hail, Full of Grace! The Lord is with you" (Lk 1:28). Such is the greeting that Mary gets from the angel Gabriel. "Do not be afraid, Zechariah, because your prayer has been heard" (Lk 1:13). These are the first words Zechariah hears when he encounters the angel from God.

What beautiful greetings from the angel of God to the people of faith! I pray that I can hear this every day. Truthfully, the same greeting from God comes to us all the time, and our lack of faith causes us not to pay much attention to it. The hustle and bustle of life might be a factor, and our deliberation to reject it might be a real factor because of our reluctance to have God over us. Mary heard it and asked for clarification because she was convinced that "nothing is impossible for God" (Lk 1:37). As a result, Mary became blessed, and Jesus was born. Zechariah heard it, however, and asked for proof because he knew that, realistically, he and his wife were too old. As a result, Zechariah was silenced until he wrote down John as the name of his son.

Friends, though this year's Advent season is short, I am convinced that our preparation for the birth of the Messiah is sufficient: the Word becomes flesh and dwells within us. Here is a lesson for us from Mary and Zechariah: as we hear more of God's words through prayer, meditation, the celebration of the Eucharist and reading the Bible, we become knowledgeable, and as a result, we ought to be like Mary, who "kept all these things, reflecting on them in her heart" (Lk 2:19). As members of Our Lady of Sorrows, we are always reminded by Our Lady that we are blessed; we are not afraid; we are filled with God's grace and the Lord is with us. Faith is about our relationship with God and, therefore, nothing shall stand between us. As Isaiah states in our Gospel reading from the 2nd Sunday in Advent: "Every valley shall be filled in; every mountain and hill shall be made low; the rugged land shall be made a plain, the rough country, a broad valley" (Is 40:4). Emmanuel is His name. The coming of the Messiah will Increase Our Faith and Strengthen Our Community.
