

### PARISH FINANCIAL NEWS

On average, it costs **\$9,600** per week to run the parish. There are two sources for this amount: the Grand Annual Campaign and the weekly offertory. Last week's offertory amount was **\$5,342**, and the **six month average for electronic giving is \$3,000 per week**. Thank you to all who contributed.


For those of you who are not contributing at this time but would like to begin and for those of you who are able to increase your amount, there are two easy ways to donate:



The Book Group meets one Sunday afternoon a month to discuss books that broadly deal with spiritual or religious themes.


