PARISH FINANCIAL NEWS

On average, it costs \$9,600 per week to run the parish. There are two sources for this amount: the Grand Annual Campaign and the weekly offertory. Last week's offertory amount was \$6,131 and the six month average for electronic giving is \$3,000 per week. Thank you to all who contributed.

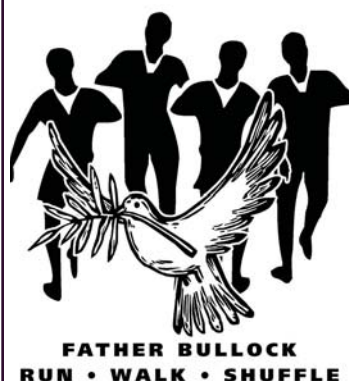
The next meeting of the OLOS Book Group is scheduled for Sunday, May 18th from 2:30-3:30 p.m.

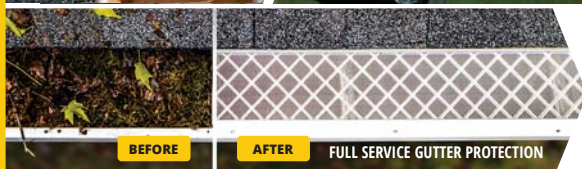
