PARISH FINANCIAL NEWS

On average, it costs **\$9,600** per week to run the parish. There are two sources for this amount: the Grand Annual Campaign and the weekly offertory. 
Memorial Mass at 11 am with a luncheon in O'Connell Hall immediately following the Mass


