## Welcome To Our New Music Director




### Krishan Oberoi

## **14th Annual Family Walk**




Saturday, June 8th 10:00 am – 2:00 pm




The next meeting of the OLOS Book Group is scheduled for Sunday, June 29th from 2:30-3:30 p.m.

### PARISH FINANCIAL NEWS

On average, it costs **\$9,600** per week to run the parish. There are two sources for this amount: the Grand Annual Campaign and the weekly offertory. Last week's offertory amount was \$2,760 and the six month average for electronic giving is \$3,000 per week. Thank you to all who contributed.
