

Saint Matthew, Apostle

One of the Twelve Apostles, this tax collector is called Matthew in one Gospel (Mt 9:9) and Levi in two others (Mk 2:14 and Lk 5:27). Scripture scholars believe they are the same man because the call and shared meal with Jesus are similar in all three accounts. He sometimes is credited with writing the Gospel of Matthew, but most scholars think this unlikely. And there is no evidence for early church traditions that Matthew evangelized in Judea, Parthia or Ethiopia, or that he was martyred in Persia.

As Jesus passed by, he saw a man named Matthew sitting at the customs post. He said to him, “Follow me.” And he got up and followed him. While he was at table in his house, many tax collectors and sinners came and sat with Jesus and his disciples. The Pharisees saw this and said to his disciples, “Why does your teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?” He heard this and said, “Those who are well do not need a physician, but the sick do. Go and learn the meaning of the words, I desire mercy, not sacrifice. I did not come to call the righteous but sinners.”

Dear friends,

Our celebration of Mass at the Lake welcomed a great number of people. We were so blessed to have such a wonderful day. God heard our prayers by holding back the rain that was predicted by our human wisdom. Two hundred and twenty people received Holy Communion during the Mass. The Scripture passage is once again fulfilled in our own hearing: a large crowd followed Jesus (mentioned about 34 times in the Bible). How great are the works of the Lord! (Psalm 111)

Rome was not built in one day and the Great Wall in China was not built by one person. The collective wisdom, work and perseverance that went into these wonders cannot easily be described in words. The beauty and holiness of our parish church reflects the great love and dedication of all members of this community since as early as 1846 when a small group of Catholics petitioned Bishop Fitzpatrick to celebrate the Holy Mass in Sharon. Though for reasons no longer known to us the name of our church building was changed to Our Lady of Sorrows in 1895, our church has always been a beacon of hope. On June 27, 1906, this mission church became an independent parish with 350 parishioners. This parish has been a light in the town of Sharon ever since.

Friends, the Mass at the Lake on September 13, 2026 will mark the 120th anniversary of our parish's independence. As your pastor, in the spirit of this Year of Hope proclaimed by Pope Francis, I invite all of you to pray and to actualize that HOPE for our future children by being good stewards, contributing your TIME, TALENT, TREASURE and TESTIMONY to build up our parish. I am going to provide you with more details as I continue to consult with the members of our various parish commissions. 
PARISH FINANCIAL NEWS



On average, it costs **\$12,100** per week to run the parish. There are two sources for this amount: the Grand Annual Campaign and the weekly offertory. Last week's offertory amount was **\$3,833** and the **six month average for electronic giving is \$4,000 per week.** Thank you to all who contributed.

For those of you who are not contributing at this time but would like to begin and for those of you who are able to increase your amount, there are two easy ways to donate:



PreK-5 Faith Formation

Classes for students in grades PreK-Grade 5 will take place in the Cottage Street Elementary School two to three Sundays a month, from 9:45-10:45 am. The first class is Sunday, September 28 at 9:45 am (with a parent orientation in the CSS cafeteria).

Middle School Faith Formation (Grades 6-7)

Classes for students in grades 6 and 7 will take place in O'Connell Hall one Sunday a month from 5 -6:30 pm. The first class is Sunday, October 5 at 5 pm. Parents of registered students will receive orientation materials by email one week prior to the first class.

Preparation for Confirmation (Grades 8-12)

This year, the Confirmation class will meet in O'Connell Hall from 7-8:30 p.m. an average of two Sundays a month. In addition, there are occasional special required programs as listed on the Confirmation class calendar on the parish website (olossharon.org). An orientation for Confirmation students and their parents will be held on Sunday, September 28 from 7-8 pm in O'Connell Hall, and the first class will take place on Sunday, October 5 from 7-8:30 pm.

All students in grades 8-12 who have not yet received the Sacrament of Confirmation are eligible to enroll in our Confirmation program.


No experience is necessary, just a love for singing praise to God.




