

Dear friends,

The “Begin the Conversation” talk with Fr. Frank Clooney and Marlene DeLeon during last Sunday’s coffee hour sparked great discussions among the people present. I was touched by people’s love for the Gospel, especially the desire to understand the true meaning of our own stewardship.



In my homily last weekend, I explained how Professor Brant Pitre uses the word “twist” to describe how Jesus teaches with his parables. Jesus came from heaven to reveal God’s Kingdom to us. Here is the twist: Jesus reminds those of us who are His disciples that our eternal home is not here on earth but in heaven and that all the things we have now do not really belong to us. We came to earth with nothing, and we leave this world without taking anything with us. Therefore, we need to use all created things entrusted to us by God as investments in our spiritual bank for eternal life.


Looking to the future of our parish as your priest, I want to remind the members of this community that we are all stewards. The development of the parish depends on our individual investments of Time, Talents, Treasure and Testimony. We entrust them in the hands of God and HE can multiply them.

After consulting with members of the Parish Pastoral Council, the Parish Finance Council, and various parish commissions, I would like to share with you some specific projects that need to be done. I do not want either to scare you or overwhelm you with this list; I just want to invite you to share your responsibility to be a steward. Three big projects need your help: the ramp connected to our church (which needs to be repaired or replaced), the stairs of the rectory (which need to be rebuilt) and the carpet in O’Connell Hall (which needs to be replaced). We are also in need of various items used in the church: a processional cross, new sacramentaries (liturgical books), candles (both the Easter and regular altar candles), new chasubles, and altar wine, etc.

I also want to let you know that, starting in October, we are adding a 7:00 am daily Mass on Thursdays and Fridays for early risers. As Psalm 122:1 says: “*Let us go to the house of the Lord.*”




PARISH FINANCIAL NEWS



On average, it costs **\$12,100** per week to run the parish. There are two sources for this amount: the Grand Annual Campaign and the weekly offertory. Last week's offertory amount was **\$4,363** and the six month average for electronic giving is **\$4,000 per week**. Thank you to all who contributed.

For those of you who are not contributing at this time but would like to begin and for those of you who are able to increase your amount, there are two easy ways to donate:



PreK-5 Faith Formation

Classes for students in grades PreK-Grade 5 will take place in the Cottage Street Elementary School two to three Sundays a month, from 9:45-10:45 am. The first class is Sunday, September 28 at 9:45 am (with a parent orientation in the CSS cafeteria).

Middle School Faith Formation (Grades 6-7)

An orientation for Confirmation students and their parents will be held on Sunday, September 28 from 7-8 pm in O'Connell Hall, and the first class will take place on Sunday, October 5 from 7-8:30 pm.

All students in grades 8-12 who have not yet received the Sacrament of Confirmation are eligible to enroll in our Confirmation program.


Saint Francis of Assisi

1182 – 1226
FEAST DAY – OCTOBER 4

The son of a wealthy Italian merchant, Francis was a playboy who experienced a profound conversion after going to war for Assisi, being imprisoned, and enduring a debilitating illness. He renounced his family and riches and lived a life of radical poverty and service because he believed Christ had asked him to. He founded the new mendicant Order of Friars Minor, or Franciscans, and helped found the Poor Clares and the Franciscan Third Order. In 2013, Argentine Cardinal Jorge Mario Bergoglio took this medieval saint's name when he was elected pope. Francis is the patron of animals, environmentalists, merchants, Catholic Action, and Italy.

During Mass on October 4, 2013, Pope Francis spoke of three ways in which he felt St. Francis could be an example Catholics today. He said:

- “ 1. The first thing he tells us is this: that being a Christian means having a living relationship with the person of Jesus; it means putting on Christ, being conformed to him. . .
2. The second witness that Francis gives us: that everyone who follows Christ receives true peace, the peace that Christ alone can give, a peace which the world cannot give. . .
3. Saint Francis of Assisi bears witness to the need to respect all that God has created and as he created it, without manipulating and destroying creation; rather to help it grow, to become more beautiful and more like what God created it to be. ”


