

Pastor's Note

Dear friends,

After comparing the size of a mustard seed to a Tylenol pill I used to take for many years, I cannot stop asking myself the questions “Where was I over the years?” and “Where was Jesus in my life?”

During my last ten years in Beijing, I took a great amount of pain relief pills for my back and leg. “If you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, ‘be uprooted and planted in the sea,’ and it would obey you.” (Luke 17:6) To be honest, I forgot to ask constantly before, and I still cannot get a tree to move, nor can I plant it in the sea. It is clear that my faith is not even a very small amount.

Increase our faith! After listening to the teachings of Jesus, the apostles realize they need to experience a great leap of faith to understand and carry out Jesus’ mission of love, forgiveness, compassion, repentance, sacrifice, humility, service and stewardship. The Scriptures tell us that, even with increased faith and additional experiences, the apostles still stumbled along the way, but Jesus never abandoned them.

Friends, no matter what happens in life, God always acts as a compassionate parent to the prophets, to the disciples, and to us as well. We often think of God from our own perspective and ask “why?” The Bible shows us in many places how God feels about us. In this past Wednesday’s reading, Jonah is displeased with God for sparing the city of Nineveh. God’s response to Jonah- “Should I not be concerned over Nineveh, the great city, in which there are more than a hundred and twenty thousand persons...?”- reveals God’s parental care and compassion, as well as His parental heartbreak. Jesus’ teaching in the Gospel of the day makes the nature of our relationship clear: we are all brothers and sisters, and we have one Father in heaven.

May Our Lady of the Rosary always intercede for us. May our faith be increased and may we do God’s will.


PARISH FINANCIAL NEWS



On average, it costs **\$12,100** per week to run the parish. There are two sources for this amount: the Grand Annual Campaign and the weekly offertory. For those of you who are not contributing at this time but would like to begin and for those of you who are able to increase your amount, there are two easy ways to donate:




