

Pastor's Note

Dear Friends,

Last Sunday night, after a delicious dinner and great conversation with some friends, I decided to sleep in on Monday morning. At about 1 am, after about two pages of night reading, my alarm clock was off, my lights were out, and my horizontal meditation had begun. Rarely do I go to bed that late.

I don't know whether I was still awake or dreaming, but suddenly I heard a phone ring. Thinking it was my day off, I decided no action was needed. Suddenly, I saw my mother, whom I have not seen for a long time. No words, no actions, just her smiling face. Mom is here, I told myself, and got up immediately to answer the phone. All was quiet. There were no sounds, and no one in the room with me. It was a dream. To be sure, I ran downstairs to my office and turned on the computer, where I heard a recorded voice message from a man asking me to go over to his house. His mother had just passed... It was 7:14 am.

Friends, do you believe in the Communion of Saints? Of course, we do. It was my mother who got me up as she used to do all the time when she was alive. Whenever we recite the Apostle's Creed, we profess that "I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the Communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting." This belief becomes even more real as we prepare ourselves to enter the month of November, which is dedicated to the Holy Souls in Purgatory with the two very important observances of All Saints' Day and All Souls' Day, at which we emphasize our prayers and remember of all the deceased, especially our loved ones.

On Sunday, November 2, All Souls' Day, our parish will hold a memorial Mass for those who have died and been buried from our parish family this past year. We know that through God's love and mercy our prayers can help. During this month, I will offer all the weekday Masses not otherwise booked by families for their special intentions (which I encourage all to do) for the deceased members of our parish family. May all the Saints, Angels and Archangels intercede for us so that our beloved deceased ones live in heaven, and we do well building up our church here on earth. Continue our loving relationship with the deceased as we do with Jesus.

PARISH FINANCIAL NEWS



On average, it costs **\$12,100** per week to run the parish. There are two sources for this amount: the Grand Annual Campaign and the weekly offertory. Last week's offertory amount was **\$7,059**, inclusive of the average weekly electronic giving of \$4,000. We are pleased to report that over half of the weekly offertory is given electronically. Thank you to all who contributed.


Fr. Frank Clooney sends the following update about his sabbatical trip:




