

Pastor's Note

Friends,

Many thanks need to be said after Saturday night's parish dinner for my thirtieth year anniversary in the priesthood. Thanks to the staff and volunteers for making it possible; thank you for your prayers; thank you for your support; thank you for your friendship; and thank you for your cards. Above all, we thank God together for this parish family of OLOS.

At the dinner as well as at other occasions when the topic of this anniversary has come up, people have asked me about my best memories from these thirty years. Honestly, after thinking about these years for a while, I confess that no "thank you" could ever adequately express my heartfelt gratitude to the God who loves ME. But I can borrow from the story of the Samaritan leper in this Wednesday's Gospel. Luke uses a series of vivid verbs to describe this man's profound gratitude after discovering his leprosy has been cured: *"Realizing he had been healed, he returned, glorifying God in a loud voice; and he fell at the feet of Jesus and thanked him"* (Lk 15-16).

I became a "leper" in the fall of 1993 in the eyes of a bishop who decided to take me out of St. John's Seminary before I finished my studies. I did not say YES directly to his demand without thinking too much. I became a future priest without a domicile (a canonical term) in 1995. The administrator in my home diocese claimed that he did not know me and that therefore I did not belong there. I was on the verge of being excommunicated by Rome in 2006, because the Beijing government wanted to show their power and control. Each of these incidents inflicted pain and suffering on my body and my soul; every time, I prayed and asked God for help. Though these experiences were painful and excruciating indeed, God came to my rescue.

Friends, no life is easy, but all life is beautiful. The Cross is the must-go-through way to heaven. Jesus took the Cross upon himself, willing to die for us so that we do not have to die anymore. How blessed we are today simply to think about it. Be grateful, be prayerful. Gratitude is essential because it is the truth. Thirty years of priesthood helps me understand one simple truth: as the Samaritan man shows in the Gospel, we always return to God after the Lord graces us. We return and glorify God with voice and action. Faith never disappoints us. Come to Jesus for healing and leave Him with Faith.

PARISH FINANCIAL NEWS




On average, it costs **\$12,100** per week to run the parish. There are two sources for this amount: the Grand Annual Campaign and the weekly offertory. Last week's offertory amount was **\$9,930**, inclusive of the average weekly electronic giving of \$4,000. We are pleased to report that over half of the weekly offertory is given electronically. Share the Word of God by proclaiming the first and second readings and reading the General Intercessions during weekday and Sunday Masses. Lectors usually work in pairs.




EUCCHARISTIC MINISTERS


The next meeting of the OLOS Book Group is scheduled for Sunday, December 26th from 2:30-3:30 p.m.
