Fr. John's Notes

Dear St. Joseph Family,

Thank you for your faith and generosity. You inspire me!

Two works of art come to mind in pondering this Sunday's gospel: Peter Jackson's motion picture, *The Lord of the Rings: The Two Towers*, and Luca Signorelli's fresco, *Sermon and Deeds of the Antichrist*. The former you can find wherever movies are sold and the latter in Orvieto, Italy at the side chapel of the Orvieto Cathedral.

Towards the end of *The Two Towers*, adapted from JRR Tolkien's novel, the previously thought impenetrable refuge of Helm's Deep is completely overrun by Saruman's Uruk-hai army (the evil guys). An utterly demoralized King of Rohan and small band of survivors, including Aragorn (the good guys), huddle in a room awaiting their certain death.

Despairingly perplexed, the King of Rohan asks, "So much death, what can men do against such reckless hate?" A foolhardy Aragorn responds with increasing resoluteness, "Ride out with me. Ride out and meet them." Someone then notices the sun is rising at which point Aragorn recalls Gandalf's promise and prophecy to reunite with them at dawn. Epic music swells while the daring survivors mount their horses and ride into the massive Uruk-hai army toward the eastern sunrise where an equally massive cavalry led by Gandalf arrives and conquers the day.

In Signorelli's fresco, a figure resembling Christ, but listening to Satan, seduces people away from the truth of the faith and toward himself. The antichrist incites brutal slaughter, ransacking of the Church, corruption (a woman sells herself to a merchant), idolatry (people leave valuable gifts at the antichrist's feet), and miraculous events. In the midst of this craziness, a small group of Christians

huddle together like a fortress and pray. And at the top left, an angel hurls down the antichrist and unleashes God's wrath upon his followers.

Both works of art portray small but courageous groups enduring the seemingly triumphant evil all around them. Their perseverance is met with definitive divine intervention.

Today, Jesus prophesies and warns us about the Church's final and ultimate trial that will rock the Church to its foundation (see Catechism #675-7 for more detail). Whether or not we're still alive when Satan unleashes his final evil offensive, Jesus is calling us to perseverance because evil will come our way during our life. Like Aragorn and his small band of survivors in Tolkien's story or the small group of Christians in Signorelli's fresco, we are called to persevere as Christians with courage and faith in Jesus' promises ("there will arise the sun of justice with its healing rays" Mal 3:20).

The Christian, St. Augustine wrote, has a twofold task: to do good and to endure evil. Bearing the name Christian does not exempt evil from happening to us, it paradoxically attracts it because evil is parasitic of the good. Like Christ on the cross, if we endure the evil done to us with Christ and His strength, then we shall also share in His eternal victory: "by your perseverance you will secure your lives" (Lk 21:19).




