Prepare the way for the Lord

PARISH ADVENT DEVOTIONAL

This year, to prepare the way of the Lord collectively as a parish community – moving back to our renovated church, still navigating through the trying days of 2020 – , we will have a parish devotional/activity each weekend of advent to truly put Christ back in Christmas and remember the "reason for the season"

Second Sunday of Advent

Prepare the way of the Lord (Mk 1:3;cf. ls 40:3)

The season of Advent recalls in a literal sense the days of "preparation" before the entrance of the Lord Jesus into human history in the Incarnation at Christmas. However, we should always remember to prepare ourselves for His coming to us each day in the Sacrament, the Eucharist. As Saint John reminds us, the way we show our love of God is principally through Christian charity, for whoever does not love a brother whom he has seen cannot love God whom he has not seen (1 Jn 4:20). Uniting these two senses, parishioners are encouraged to provide baby diapers which will be collected before and after each of the Masses on Dec. 5/6, to be given to the Divine Mercy House and other Women's Help Centers.

Third Sunday of Advent

Bring glad tidings to the poor (Is 61:1)

On the Third Sunday of Advent, we hear the prophetic words of Isaiah on the messianic mission which Jesus fulfills in His Person (indeed, the words he proclaims are fulfilled at the beginning of His public ministry in Saint Luke's Gospel). By virtue of our Christian vocation - and in particular by virtue of the Sacrament of Confirmation, in which we, too, are anointed in this kingly office of the Lord Jesus - we also are called to bring glad tidings to the poor, to heal the broken-hearted, to proclaim liberty to captives and release to the prisoners (Is 61:1). Blessed as we are to have Deacon Corky, the Diocesan Director of Prison Ministry, our parish activity this week will be writing Christmas cards to those in prison. Please bring your Christmas card in a stamped envelope, unsealed, and signed only with your first names to Masses on the weekend of Dec. 12/13, and as you receive the mailing label, remember to pray for the person you will adopt in a special way this Advent/Christmas season.

First Sunday of Advent

Be watchful! Be alert! (Mk 13:33)

Part of remaining watchful and vigilant in the life of faith, as the Rite of Baptism states, is to have the light of faith "kept burning brightly, so that [we] may walk always as a child of the light and, perservering in the Lord when he comes". To remind us of our lofty Christian vocation, each family is encouraged to bring their advent candles or other candles that serve to illuminate your family prayer times and dinners to be blessed at each of the Masses on Nov. 28/29, the First Sunday of Advent.

Fourth Sunday of Advent

Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord (Lk 1:38)

In a special way, the Fourth Sunday of Advent always reminds us of the Lord's indwelling, particularly focusing on the perfect example given by the handmaid of Nazareth, Mary, our Mother and Queen. Join us after our two evening Masses - after the 5:30pm Vigil on Dec. 19 and after the 5pm Sunday Mass on Dec. 20 - outside the main church for a candlelight rosary.




