



## INVITATION TO COME CLOSER TO JESUS

We are all Blessed to be members of St. Joseph Catholic Church because of its deep devotion to Jesus Christ and the numerous ministries it has to offer. The ministries reach out to help build Christian community, help the homeless, the poor, the elderly, etc. in our community.

I would like to share with you one of those ministries that is very dear to me. It is the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, also known as the EMHC Ministry. Have you ever felt a desire to become closer to Christ? If you have, this may be just the right ministry God is calling you to get involved in. Think about it, you are actually holding in your hands the Body and Blood of Christ, then serving it to the faithful. How much closer to Jesus can you get? Many of our EMHCs strive to serve at the Main Church at least twice a month; some even more just to be closer to our Lord Jesus Christ. Also, many of EMHCs take advantage of the opportunities to take Holy Communion to the assisted living facilities, hospitals or homebound in our community. If you ever wanted to feel appreciated, serve Holy Communion to the elderly, the sick and the homebound at these facilities. They will really show their appreciation to you. 1 Peter 4:10 NAB – “As each one has received a gift, use it to serve one another as good stewards of God’s varied grace.”

If you feel Jesus is calling you for this ministry, here is what you must do.

1. Practice your Catholic Faith and be in good standing with the Church.
2. Pray to Jesus about it.
3. Send an email to Fr. Sebastian (frseb@stjosephjax.org), or Dcn. Kevin Boudreaux (dcnkevin@stjosephjax.org) and copy me (sjemhc@stjosephjax.org) explaining why you feel Jesus called you to serve God as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion.

5. Also include any additional information you feel would be worthy of consideration.



## BECOMING A CATHOLIC


The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

### BASIC PREP INFORMATION

#### CATHOLIC SCHOOL ATTENDEES

Students attending **St. Joseph's Catholic School**, or another Catholic school, receive religious formation training for each grade, K - 8, within the programs of their school.

#### PUBLIC SCHOOL ATTENDEES

Students attending **public schools** must register each year, K - 8 grade, to receive proper credit for their religious formation training through PREP.

Both First Holy Communion and Confirmation require two years of sacramental preparation so please plan accordingly.

- Communion: 1st and 2nd Grades
- Confirmation: 7th and 8th Grades

#### HOME-SCHOOLING ATTENDEES

Families with students attending full-time home-schooling classes must submit a St. Joseph's PREP registration form and register with the JPII (St. John Paul II) Homeschool program.

### ABOUT THE PROGRAM

In heeding the Church's call for acceptable catechesis for all baptized individuals, including any child with special needs, St. Joseph's Catholic Church's Parish Religious Education Program (PREP) offers three adaptive models to meet the needs of each child's faith formation.

The St. Joseph's PREP Special Needs Program includes specialized catechetical support. Parents will have monthly meetings/trainings on using the Loyola Press Adaptive tools and program.

### ADAPTIVE PROGRAM

Our Special Needs Care Team are here to walk with you to provide faith formation for your child. When you register for Special Needs, the team will work with you and provide an assessment to help determine the best program model for your child.

### MODELS

#### INTEGRATIVE MODEL

In our integrative model, students are integrated into a regular PREP classroom. Additionally, students will receive a supplemental adapted lesson for continued formation at home.

#### SPECTRUM A (HOME-BASED)

An adaptive program specialized for students who are high-functioning in their learning capabilities.

#### SPECTRUM B (HOME-BASED)

An adaptive program specialized for children who may need additional assistance on their learning needs and abilities.




