Did you Know?

¿Sabías qué?

We are continuing in Pope St. John Paul II's encyclical, *Ecclesia de Eucharistia*, given to us on Holy Thursday in 2003. It builds on many of the concepts of *Mysterium Fidei* published directly after Vatican II.

The Ecclesial Communities separated from us (from the 16th century onward) lack that fullness of unity with us which should flow from Baptism, and we believe that especially because of the lack of the sacrament of Orders they have not preserved the genuine and total reality of the Eucharistic mystery... The Catholic faithful, therefore, while respecting the religious convictions of these separated brethren, must refrain from receiving communion distributed in their celebrations so as not to condone an ambiguity about the nature of the Eucharist..." (#30)

Annulments

Your parish Priests and Deacons understand the pain of those for whom divorce seemed the only recourse. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) encourages divorced persons who wish to marry in the Catholic Church to seek counsel about existing options that may remedy their marital situation, including the suitability of an annulment when there is no longer any hope of reconciliation of the spouses.

An annulment is a declaration by the Diocesan Tribunal (a local Catholic church court) that a marriage thought to be valid according to Church law actually fell short of at least one of the essential elements required for a binding union. 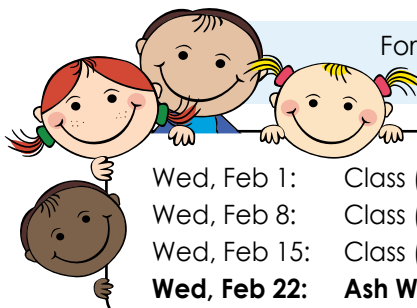

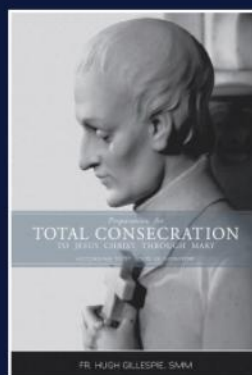
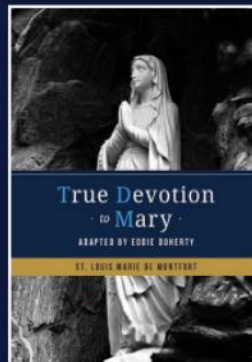

Divine Mercy

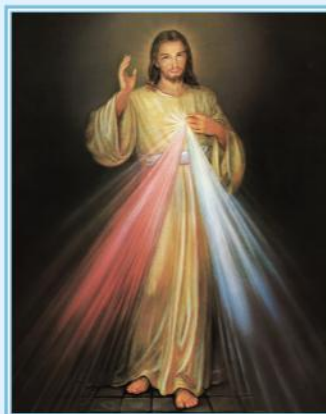

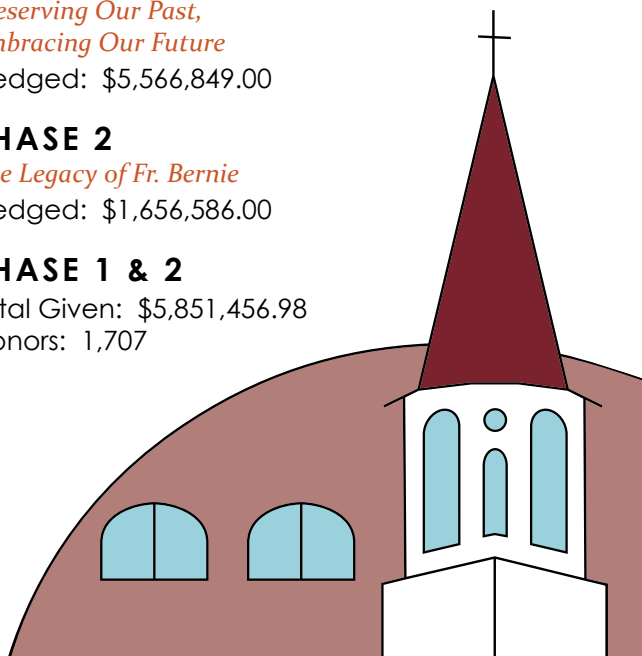
