Jesus died on the cross at 3 o'clock in the afternoon. That is why Jesus told St. Faustina that the hour between 3 and 4 o'clock in the afternoon, every day of the year, is known as the Hour of Great Mercy. During that hour, Jesus asked St. Faustina to try to pray the Stations of the Cross, but He also told her "...if you are not able to make the Stations of the Cross, then at least step into the chapel for a moment and ADORE, in the Blessed Sacrament, My Heart, which is full of mercy; and should you be unable to step into the chapel, IMMERSE yourself in prayer there where you happen to be, if only for a very brief instant" (Diary, 1572). At three o'clock, implore My mercy, especially for sinners; and, if only for a brief moment, IMMERSE yourself in My Passion, particularly in My abandonment at the moment of agony. This is the hour of

great mercy for the whole world. I will allow you to enter into My mortal sorrow. In this hour, I will refuse nothing to the soul that makes a request of Me in virtue of My Passion..." (Diary 1320)

During this hour, Jesus wants us to remember His sacrifice: what He did for us on the Cross out of love for us. He wants our love in return. During this hour, we should pray for our loved ones and for the conversion of sinners. We can also pray the 3 o'clock prayer, which is normally prayed with the Chaplet of Divine Mercy:

"You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty yourself out upon us" (Diary 1319). O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You!" (Diary 84)

During this Blessed Hour, a soul could also pray the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary.

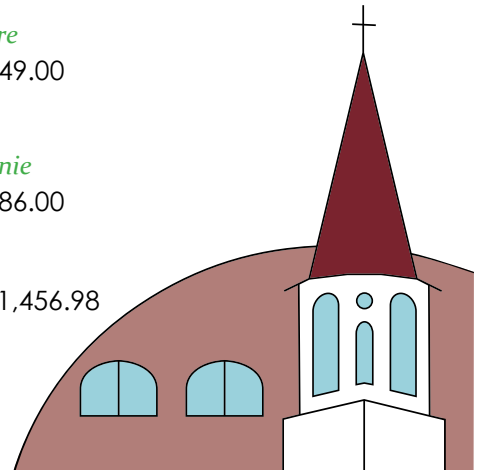
