We are continuing in Pope St. John Paul II's encyclical, Ecclesia de Eucharistia, given to us on Holy Thursday in 2003. It builds on many of the concepts of Mysterium Fidei published directly after Vatican II.

"Precisely because the Church's unity... absolutely requires full communion in the bonds of the profession of faith, the sacraments, and ecclesiastical governance, it is not possible to celebrate together the same Eucharistic liturgy until those bonds are fully reestablished." (#44)
