We are continuing in Pope St. John Paul II's encyclical, Ecclesia de Eucharistia, given to us on Holy Thursday in 2003. It builds on many of the concepts of Mysterium Fidei published directly after Vatican II.

"If we wish to rediscover...the relationship between the Church and the Eucharist, we cannot neglect Mary, Mother and model of the Church.... At first glance, the Gospel is silent on this subject.... But in addition to her sharing in the Eucharistic banquet, an indirect picture of Mary's relationship with the Eucharist can be had, beginning with her interior disposition. Mary is a woman of the Eucharist." (#53)

Annulments

Your parish Priests and Deacons understand the pain of those for whom divorce seemed the only recourse. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) encourages divorced persons who wish to marry in the Catholic Church to seek counsel about existing options that may remedy their marital situation, including the suitability of an annulment when there is no longer any hope of reconciliation of the spouses.

An annulment is a declaration by the Diocesan Tribunal (a local Catholic church court) that a marriage thought to be valid according to Church law actually fell short of at least one of the essential elements required for a binding union.
