We have switched our document this summer to Pope Benedict's Sacramentum Caritatis, Sacrament of Charity. This post-synodal apostolic exhortation was given on the Feast of the Chair of St. Peter, February 22, 2007. It is the result of the 11th Synod of Bishops, called by Pope St. John Paul II.

"Saint Augustine...speaking specifically of the eucharistic mystery, stresses the fact that Christ assimilates us to himself: 'The bread you see on the altar, sanctified by the word of God, is the body of Christ. The chalice, or rather, what the chalice contains, sanctified by the word of God, is the blood of Christ. In these signs, Christ the Lord willed to entrust to us his body and the blood which he shed for the forgiveness of our sins. If you have received them properly, you yourselves are what you have received'" (36).

"San Agustín... Hablando específicamente del misterio eucarístico, subraya el hecho de que Cristo nos asimila a sí mismo: "El pan que veis en el altar, santificado por la Palabra de Dios, es el cuerpo de Cristo. El cáliz, o mejor dicho, lo que contiene el cáliz, santificado por la palabra de Dios, es la sangre de Cristo. En estos signos, Cristo el Señor quiso confiarnos su cuerpo y la sangre que derramó para el perdón de nuestros pecados. Si los habéis recibido correctamente, vosotros mismos sois lo que habéis recibido" (36).

Annulments

Your parish Priests and Deacons understand the pain of those for whom divorce seemed the only recourse. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) encourages divorced persons who wish to marry in the Catholic Church to seek counsel about existing options that may remedy their marital situation, including the suitability of an annulment when there is no longer any hope of reconciliation of the spouses.

An annulment is a declaration by the Diocesan Tribunal (a local Catholic church court) that a marriage thought to be valid according to Church law actually fell short of at least one of the essential elements required for a binding union.
