Did you Know? ¿Sabías qué?

We have switched our document this summer to Pope Benedict's Sacramentum Caritatis, Sacrament of Charity. This post-synodal apostolic exhortation was given on the Feast of the Chair of St. Peter, February 22, 2007. It is the result of the 11th Synod of Bishops, called by Pope St. John Paul II.

"It should be made clear that the word 'participation' does not refer to mere external activity during the celebration. In fact, the active participation called for by the Council must be understood in more substantial terms, on the basis of a greater awareness of the mystery being celebrated and its relationship to daily life" (52).

Annulments

Your parish Priests and Deacons understand the pain of those for whom divorce seemed the only recourse. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) encourages divorced persons who wish to marry in the Catholic Church to seek counsel about existing options that may remedy their marital situation, including the suitability of an annulment when there is no longer any hope of reconciliation of the spouses.

An annulment is a declaration by the Diocesan Tribunal (a local Catholic church court) that a marriage thought to be valid according to Church law actually fell short of at least one of the essential elements required for a binding union.
