We have switched our document this summer to Pope Benedict's Sacramentum Caritatis, Sacrament of Charity. This post-synodal apostolic exhortation was given on the Feast of the Chair of St. Peter, February 22, 2007. It is the result of the 11th Synod of Bishops, called by Pope St. John Paul II.

"The Eucharist in fact not only manifests our personal communion with Jesus Christ, but also implies full communion with the Church. This is the reason why, sadly albeit not without hope, we ask Christians who are not Catholic to understand and respect our conviction, which is grounded in the Bible and Tradition. We hold that eucharistic communion and ecclesial communion are so linked as to make it generally impossible for non-Catholic Christians to receive the former without enjoying the latter" (56).

"En efecto, la Eucaristía no sólo manifiesta nuestra comunión personal con Jesucristo, sino que implica también plena communion con la Iglesia. Esta es la razón por la cual, tristemente, aunque no sin esperanza, pedimos a los cristianos que no son católicos que comprendan y respeten nuestra convicción, que se basa en la Biblia y la Tradición. Sostenemos que la comunión eucarística y la comunión eclesial están tan vinculadas que hacen generalmente imposible que los cristianos no católicos reciban la primera sin disfrutar de la segunda" (56).

Annulments

Your parish Priests and Deacons understand the pain of those for whom divorce seemed the only recourse. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) encourages divorced persons who wish to marry in the Catholic Church to seek counsel about existing options that may remedy their marital situation, including the suitability of an annulment when there is no longer any hope of reconciliation of the spouses.

An annulment is a declaration by the Diocesan Tribunal (a local Catholic church court) that a marriage thought to be valid according to Church law actually fell short of at least one of the essential elements required for a binding union.
