We have switched our document this summer to Pope Benedict's Sacramentum Caritatis, Sacrament of Charity. This post-synodal apostolic exhortation was given on the Feast of the Chair of St. Peter, February 22, 2007. It is the result of the 11th Synod of Bishops, called by Pope St. John Paul II.

"Significantly, the Synod Fathers stated that 'the Christian faithful need a fuller understanding of the relationship between the Eucharist and their daily lives. Eucharistic spirituality is not just participation in Mass and devotion to the Blessed Sacrament. It embraces the whole of life....' Hence the Eucharist, as the source and summit of the Church's life and mission, must be translated into spirituality, into a life lived 'according to the Spirit'" (77).

"Significativamente, los Padres sinodales han afirmado que 'los fieles cristianos necesitan una comprensión más completa de la relación entre la Eucaristía y su vida cotidiana. La espiritualidad eucarística no es sólo la participación en la Misa y la devoción al Santísimo Sacramento. Abarca toda la vida ...' Por lo tanto, la Eucaristía, como fuente y culmen de la vida y de la misión de la Iglesia, debe traducirse en espiritualidad, en una vida vivida "según el Espíritu" (77).

Annulments

Your parish Priests and Deacons understand the pain of those for whom divorce seemed the only recourse. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) encourages divorced persons who wish to marry in the Catholic Church to seek counsel about existing options that may remedy their marital situation, including the suitability of an annulment when there is no longer any hope of reconciliation of the spouses.

An annulment is a declaration by the Diocesan Tribunal (a local Catholic church court) that a marriage thought to be valid according to Church law actually fell short of at least one of the essential elements required for a binding union.
