We have switched our document this summer to Pope Benedict's Sacramentum Caritatis, Sacrament of Charity. This post-synodal apostolic exhortation was given on the Feast of the Chair of St. Peter, February 22, 2007. It is the result of the 11th Synod of Bishops, called by Pope St. John Paul II.

"'All who partake of the Eucharist must commit themselves to peacemaking in our world scarred by violence and war, and today in particular, by terrorism, economic corruption and sexual exploitation.' All these problems give rise in turn to others no less troubling and disheartening. We know that there can be no superficial solutions to these issues. Precisely because of the mystery we celebrate, we must denounce situations contrary to human dignity, since Christ shed his blood for all, and at the same time affirm the inestimable value of each individual person" (89).

Annulments

Your parish Priests and Deacons understand the pain of those for whom divorce seemed the only recourse. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) encourages divorced persons who wish to marry in the Catholic Church to seek counsel about existing options that may remedy their marital situation, including the suitability of an annulment when there is no longer any hope of reconciliation of the spouses.

An annulment is a declaration by the Diocesan Tribunal (a local Catholic church court) that a marriage thought to be valid according to Church law actually fell short of at least one of the essential elements required for a binding union.
