

Did you Know? ¿Sabías qué?

We have switched our document this summer to Pope Benedict's Sacramentum Caritatis, Sacrament of Charity, This post-synodal apostolic exhortation was given on the Feast of the Chair of St. Peter, February 22, 2007. It is the result of the 11th Synod of Bishops, called by Pope St. John Paul II.

"There is a particular need for clarity with regard to the specific functions of the priest. He alone, and no other, as the tradition of the Church attests, presides over the entire eucharistic celebration, from the initial greeting to the final blessing. In virtue of his reception of Holy Orders, he represents Jesus Christ, the head of the Church, and, in a specific way, also the Church herself" (53).

EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2023

REV. DAVID RUCHINSKI

Father David Ruchinski was born in Warren, Ohio and araduated in 1987 from John F. Kennedy High School. He received his Bachelor's Degree in English and Philosophy in 1990 from the Pontifical College Josephinum and received his Master of Arts Degree in English from the Ohio State University in 1994. He was awarded his Doctor of Education in 2001 from the University of North Florida. In 2002, Fr. David entered the major seminary of the North American College in Rome and was awarded his Licentiate in Sacred Theology from the Gregorian University. He was ordained a priest for the Diocese of St. Augustine on June 23, 2007 by Bishop Victor Galeone at the Cathedral Basilica.

Fr. Ruchinski was assigned as Parochial Vicar for St. Augustine Church and Catholic Student Center, as well as Associate Director of Vocations for the Diocese of St. Augustine, on July 15, 2008, and Pastoral Director of St. Patrick Interparish School on June 1, 2009. Soon afterward, he was appointed Pastor and Director of St. Augustine Church and Catholic Student Center in August 2010, and became Director of Vocations in 2012.

From 2013 to 2017, Fr. Ruchinski split his time between Gainesville and Jacksonville, serving as both Diocesan Vocation Director and Director of Campus Ministry at

UF. Then, in 2018, he was reappointed as pastor of St. Augustine's parish and ended his service in the vocations office. He has served as pastor there since that time, and comes to us as the new pastor of St. Joseph, effective July 1, 2023.

Annulments

Your parish Priests and Deacons understand the pain of those for whom divorce seemed the only recourse. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) encourages divorced persons who wish to marry in the Catholic Church to seek counsel about existing options that may remedy their marital situation, including the suitability of an annulment when there is no longer any hope of reconciliation of the spouses.

An annulment is a declaration by the Diocesan Tribunal (a local Catholic church court) that a marriage thought to be valid according to Church law actually fell short of at least one of the essential elements required for a binding union. 
