WHEN A PERSON REQUESTS HOLY COMMUNION AT HOME

A person wanting to receive Holy Communion at home, due to a medical condition that is preventing Mass attendance, **should first call the SJCC Parish Office 904-268-5422**. Information will be gathered; their needs will be assessed for what SJCC can provide and next steps will be taken.

The request for Holy Communion at home is the initial request, but there are other things to consider: parish registration, geographical area, the need to see a priest for counsel, Confession, Anointing, and determining if there are other needs that can be handled through SJCC or directed to the appropriate agency. This initial process needs to be handled through the SJCC Office.

When the person is ready to receive Holy Communion at home through the Homebound Ministry an email will be sent to the Homebound Ministry contact person (Jackie West) and Deacon Bob Gardner. The email will give a brief description of the person's situation, their name, address and the contact person's name and phone number.

Jackie West visits the person the following weekend, has a Communion Service and gets to know the person. This may take a visit or two, depending on the situation. Sometimes, especially after surgery, two or three visits are all that is needed. When ready, they will be transitioned into the Homebound Ministry rotation schedule with the other EMHC.



Annulments

Your parish Priests and Deacons understand the pain of those for whom divorce seemed the only recourse. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) encourages divorced persons who wish to marry in the Catholic Church to seek counsel about existing options that may remedy their marital situation, including the suitability of an annulment when there is no longer any hope of reconciliation of the spouses.

An annulment is a declaration by the Diocesan Tribunal (a local Catholic church court) that a marriage thought to be valid according to Church law actually fell short of at least one of the essential elements required for a binding union.

STEWARDSHIP MOMENT...

Stewardship is not optional! "None of us lives as his own master and none of us dies as his own master," says St. Paul. "While we live, we are responsible to the Lord, and when we die, we die as His servants."

Did you Know? ¿Sabías qué?

We are moving now to the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy. The Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy (SC) is a document of Vatican II signed by Pope Paul VI on December 4, 1963. As a Constitution, it is binding teaching for the whole Church.

"...No other person, even if he be a priest, may add, remove, or change anything in the lituray on his own authority. That sound tradition may be retained, and yet the way remain open to legitimate progress careful investigation is always to be made into each part of the liturgy which is to be revised. This investigation should be theological, historical, and pastoral. Also the general laws governing the structure and meaning of the liturgy must be studied in conjunction with the experience derived from recent liturgical reforms and from the indults conceded to various places. Finally, there must be no innovations unless the good of the Church genuinely and certainly requires them; and care must be taken that any new forms adopted should in some way grow organically from forms already existing" (SC, ## 22-23).

Finalmente, no debe haber innovaciones a menos que el bien de la Iglesia las exija genuina y ciertamente; y se debe tener cuidado de que las nuevas formas adoptadas crezcan orgánicamente de alguna manera a partir de formas ya existentes" (SC, ## 22-23).




