





TO COME CLOSER TO JESUS

As members of St. Joseph Catholic Church, we are truly blessed because of its deep devotion to Jesus Christ and the numerous ministries it has to offer. These ministries reach out to build Christian community, help the homeless, the poor, the elderly, and serve in so many other ways. I would like to share with you one of the ministries that is very dear to me: Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, also known as the EMHC Ministry.

Have you ever felt a desire to become closer to Christ? The EMHC may be the ministry God is calling you to get involved with. Serving as an EMHC means holding in your hands the Body and Blood of Christ, and in turn, serving the faithful. We request that our EMHC's strive to serve at the Main Church at least once a month, though some choose to serve more often to be closer to our Lord. Also, many EMHC's utilize opportunities to take Holy Communion to assisted living facilities, hospitals, or to those who are homebound in our community. Serving Holy Communion to the elderly, the sick, and the homebound is a humbling experience and a true gift, both for the one who receives and the one who gives. For those who are not able to come to Mass, this time with you and our Lord means the world to them.

If you feel Jesus is calling you toward this ministry, we require the following:

- 1. Pray to Jesus about it.
- 2. Be Catholic and in good standing with the Church. (For clarification on what it means to "be in good standing" please contact me and I will be happy to help.)
- Send an email to Dcn. Kevin Boudreaux dcnkevin@ stjosephsjax.org and myself sjemhc@stjosephsjax.org explaining why you feel Jesus has called you to serve as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion.
- 4. List all ministries you have served with at St. Joseph's and other parishes.
- Include any additional information you feel would be worthy of consideration.
- St. Joseph will begin serving the Blood of Christ again within the next few months. We need additional EMHCs to assist with serving Holy Communion, not only at the Sunday Masses, but also to the homebound, in nursing homes, and assisted living facilities. If you are already an EMHC and are not currently serving, we would love to have you back. STEWARDSHIP MOMENT...

The first son in today's Gospel said he would do his father's bidding but did not. The second son balked at first, but then repented and did as he was asked. What service is God calling me to do? Which son am I more like?

Did you Know? ¿Sabías qué?

We are moving now to the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy. The Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy (SC) is a document of Vatican II signed by Pope Paul VI on December 4, 1963. As a Constitution, it is binding teaching for the whole Church.

"In liturgical celebrations each person, minister or layman, who has an office to perform, should do all of, but only, those parts which pertain to his office by the nature of the rite and the principles of liturgy. Servers, lectors commentators, and members of the choir also exercise a genuine liturgical function. They ought, therefore, to discharge their office with the sincere piety and decorum demanded by so exalted a ministry and rightly expected of them by God's people. Consequently, they must all be deeply imbued with the spirit of the liturgy, each in his own measure, and they must be trained to perform their functions in a correct and orderly manner" (SC, ## 28-29).

"En las celebraciones litúrgicas, cada persona, ministro o laico, que tenga un oficio que desempeñar, debe hacer todas, pero sólo aquellas partes que pertenecen a su oficio por la naturaleza del rito y los principios de la liturgia. Los servidores, los lectores, los comentaristas y los miembros del coro también ejercen una función litúrgica genuina. Deben, por lo tanto, desempeñar su cargo con la piedad sincera y el decoro que exige un ministerio tan exaltado y que justamente espera de ellos el pueblo de Dios. En consecuencia, todos deben estar profundamente imbuidos del espíritu de la liturgia, cada uno en su propia medida, y deben ser preparados para desempeñar sus funciones de manera correcta y ordenada" (SC, ## 28-29).






