

Sunulments

Your parish Priests and Deacons understand the pain of those for whom divorce seemed the only recourse. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) encourages divorced persons who wish to marry in the Catholic Church to seek counsel about existing options that may remedy their marital situation, including the suitability of an annulment when there is no longer any hope of reconciliation of the spouses.

An annulment is a declaration by the Diocesan Tribunal (a local Catholic church court) that a marriage thought to be valid according to Church law actually fell short of at least one of the essential elements required for a binding union.

### STEWARDSHIP MOMENT...

In the Gospel today, the owner of the vineyard sent messengers to collect his share of the harvest from the tenant farmers, but there was not a single good steward on the property! God is the owner, we are the tenants. What sort of stewards are we?



We are moving now to the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy. The Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy (SC) is a document of Vatican II signed by Pope Paul VI on December 4, 1963. As a Constitution, it is binding teaching for the whole Church.

"Even in the liturgy, the Church has no wish to impose a rigid uniformity in matters which do not implicate the faith or the good of the whole community; rather does she respect and foster the genius and talents of the various races and peoples. Anything in these peoples' way of life which is not indissolubly bound up with superstition and error she studies with sympathy and, if possible, preserves intact. Sometimes in fact she admits such things into the liturgy itself, so long as they harmonize with its true and authentic spirit" (SC, # 37).

"Incluso en la liturgia, la Iglesia no quiere imponer una rígida uniformidad en asuntos que no implican la fe o el bien de toda la comunidad; más bien respeta y fomenta el genio y los talentos de las diversas razas y pueblos. Todo lo que en el modo de vida de estos pueblos no esté indisolublemente ligado a la superstición y al error, lo estudia con simpatía y, si es posible, lo conserva intacto. A veces, de hecho, admite tales cosas en la liturgia misma, siempre que armonicen con su verdadero y auténtico espíritu" (SC, # 37).


