Did you Know? ¿Sabías qué?

"Pastors of souls should see to it that the chief hours, especially Vespers, are celebrated in common in church on Sundays and the more solemn feasts. And the laity, too, are encouraged to recite the divine office, either with the priests, or among themselves, or even individually. [Also,] any cleric bound to the divine office fulfills his obligation if he prays the office in the vernacular together with a group of the faithful...provided that the text of the translation is approved" (##100-101).
