Annulments

Your parish Priests and Deacons understand the pain of those for whom divorce seemed the only recourse. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) encourages divorced persons who wish to marry in the Catholic Church to seek counsel about existing options that may remedy their marital situation, including the suitability of an annulment when there is no longer any hope of reconciliation of the spouses.

An annulment is a declaration by the Diocesan Tribunal (a local Catholic church court) that a marriage thought to be valid according to Church law actually fell short of at least one of the essential elements required for a binding union.

Candlelight Mass February 2

If we count 40 days after the Christmas celebration, you arrive at February 2. In ancient times, the church marked this day with a special feast, as the final day the "baby Jesus" in the liturgical calendar, before the celebration of Lent.

St. Luke tells us that, while in the temple, the Holy Family met an old man names Simeon. Simeon declared that Jesus would be a "light," so the church developed the custom of lighting and blessing candles on this day.
