The Divine Mercy Journey

St. Faustina's Diary (Diary #1) begins with Jesus' command that she have an Image painted of Him. He wanted to reveal His Mercy as a font of Mercy. Pope St. John Paul II writes, "He, Himself is Mercy. To the person who sees it in Him, and finds it in Him, God becomes "visible" as THE FATHER WHO IS RICH IN MERCY (Rich in Mercy #2).

Jesus' right hand is extended as in a bless-

ing, revealing The Father as source of divine blessing. Jesus' left hand touching His garment slightly drawn aside to welcome us into His Heart. From His Heart, two rays emanate ... a red and a pale one to

recall Blood and Water gushing from His pierced side. The pale ray represents the Waters of Baptism and the Sacrament of Confession. The red ray represents the Blood, the life of souls lie: The Eucharist, "This is the chalice of my Blood, the Blood of the new and eternal covenant, ..." (Roman Missal 90)]. Jesus' left foot is forward of his right foot and to indicate a walking forward position. He is always seeking us, moving toward us. St. Faustina saw a merciful expression on His Face, with eyes slightly downward as from the Cross. The artists could never capture 'that look' but Jesus told her "Not in the beauty of the color, nor of the brush lies the greatness of this Image, but in My Grace." (Diary 313) "I am offering people a vessel with which they are to keep coming for grace to the fountain of mercy. That vessel is this image with the signature "Jesus, I trust in You" (Diary #1578)

TO COME CLOSER TO JESUS



As members of St. Joseph Catholic Church, we are truly blessed because of its deep devotion to Jesus Christ and the numerous ministries it has to offer. These ministries reach out to build Christian community, help the homeless, the poor, the elderly, and serve in so many other ways. I would like to share with you one of the ministries that is very dear to me: Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, also known as the EMHC Ministry.

Have you ever felt a desire to become closer to Christ? The EMHC may be the ministry God is calling you to get involved with. Serving as an EMHC means holding in your hands the Body and Blood of Christ, and in turn, serving the faithful. We request that our EMHC's strive to serve at the Main Church at least once a month, though some choose to serve more often to be closer to our Lord. Also, many EMHC's utilize opportunities to take Holy Communion to assisted living facilities, hospitals, or to those who are homebound in our community. Serving Holy Communion to the elderly, the sick, and the homebound is a humbling experience and a true gift, both for the one who receives and the one who gives. For those who are not able to come to Mass, this time with you and our Lord means the world to them.

If you feel Jesus is calling you toward this ministry, we require the following:

- 1. Pray to Jesus about it.
- 2. Be Catholic and in good standing with the Church. (For clarification on what it means to "be in good standing" please contact me and I will be happy to help.)
- 3. Send an email to Dcn. Kevin Boudreaux dcnkevin@ stjosephsjax.org and myself sjemhc@stjosephsjax.org explaining why you feel Jesus has called you to serve as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion.
- 4. List all ministries you have served with at St. Joseph's and other parishes.
- 5. Include any additional information you feel would be worthy of consideration.

St. Joseph will begin serving the Blood of Christ again within the next few months. We need additional EMHCs to assist with serving Holy Communion, not only at the Sunday Masses, but also to the homebound, in nursing homes, and assisted living facilities. If you are already an EMHC and are not currently serving, we would love to have you back.
