As members of St. Joseph Catholic Church, we are truly blessed because of its deep devotion to Jesus Christ and the numerous ministries it has to offer. These ministries reach out to build Christian community, help the homeless, the poor, the elderly, and serve in so many other ways. I would like to share with you one of the ministries that is very dear to me: **Extraordinary Ministers** of Holy Communion, also known as the **EMHC Ministry**.

Serving Holy Communion to the elderly, the sick, and the homebound is a humbling experience and a true gift, both for the one who receives and the one who gives. For those who are not able to come to Mass, this time with you and our Lord means the world to them.

If you feel Jesus is calling you toward this ministry, we require the following:

- 1. Pray to Jesus about it.
- 2. Be Catholic and in good standing with the Church. (For clarification on what it means to "be in good standing" please contact me and I will be happy to help.)
- 3. Send an email to Dcn. Kevin Boudreaux dcnkevin@ stjosephsjax.org and myself sjemhc@stjosephsjax.org explaining why you feel Jesus has called you to serve as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion.
- 4. List all ministries you have served with at St. Joseph's and other parishes.
- 5. Include any additional information you feel would be worthy of consideration.

St. Joseph will begin serving the Blood of Christ again within the next few months. We need additional EMHCs to assist with serving Holy Communion, not only at the Sunday Masses, but also to the homebound, in nursing homes, and assisted living facilities. If you are already an EMHC and are not currently serving, we would love to have you back. The Divine Mercy Journey

After Jesus died on the cross at 3 PM, 3 to 4 PM is known as The Hour of Great Mercy. "If you are not able to make the Stations of the Cross, then at least step into the chapel for a moment and ADORE, in the Blessed Sacrement, My Heart which is full of mercy: ... should you be unable to step into the chapel ... IMMERSE yourself in My Passion, particularly in My abandonment at the moment of agony. This is the Hour of Great Mercy for the whole world. I will

refuse nothing to the soul that makes a request of Me in virtue of My Passion." (Diary 1320) During this hour, Jesus wants us to remember His sacrifice & what He did out of love for us. He wants our love in return. We can also pray the



3 o'clock prayer from the Chaplet of Divine Mercy ... "You expired Jesus, and the source of life gushed forth for souls and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty yourself out upon us". (Diary 84) O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in you". (Diary 1319) During this Blessed Hour, a soul could also pray the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary.
