



The Divine Mercy Journey

Jesus arrives at Jerusalem after He had raised Lazarus. He is greeted by people shouting, "Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!" Then, Jesus goes to the upper room where He & the disciples participated in the Passover meal, receive His last instructions & teachings, washes their feet, institutes the Eucharist & priesthood. His treacherous betrayer leaves to alert Jesus' enemies of His whereabouts. In the Garden of Gethsemane, Jesus endures great suffering but is resolute in obeying the Father's Will. Judas reveals Him with a kiss & He is arrested. Peter, His chosen leader, denies knowing Him. Jesus is brought before the chief priests, then sent to Pilate & Herod. Finally,





The Way of the Cross helped by Simon of Cyrene. On Calvary, Jesus is crucified between two thieves. A three-hour period of agony, pain, & thirst hanging on the roughhewn cross ... ends with Jesus breathing His last at 3 o'clock.

The Crucifixion Reading 5

I saw the Lord Jesus nailed upon the cross amidst great torments. A soft moan issued from His heart. ... He said: "I thirst!" ... Join your sufferings to My passion and offer them to the Heavenly Father ... I saw two rays' issue from His side ... I offered myself, together with the dying Jesus ...

For the doubtful and naysayers ... it is over ... This hero of the people has died and is put into the tomb to be forgotten and collect dust just like several other heralded individuals. But we know that this is not the end of the story. There is an event unheard of before ... a Joyful and Glorious Resurrection ... an EASTER feast to displace the Passover Feast. An Easter Feast that will change the entire world. The darkest clouds of sorrow ... will be replaced by the brightness of eternal light. Life rises from death!!! Come Lord Jesus Come! ALLELUIA!!!







TOTAL CONSECRATION TO JESUS THROUGH MARY

All are encouraged and invited to participate in an eye-opening discernment period of 33 days to prepare for Total Consecration to Jesus through Mary as set out by St. Louis de Montfort's True Devotion to Mary. The act of entrusting oneself to Mary's care and intercession is nothing new! Jesus himself entrusted his beloved disciple, John, to Mary while he was on the Cross. The early Christians and Church Fathers recognized Mary's holiness and her significance as the Mother of God. We've been asking for Mary's intercession and intervention in our lives since the beginning of the Church. She is, after all, our mother, too.

A more formal method of consecration to Mary was developed by St. Louis de Montfort in the 1600s. His 33-day prayer consists of short instructions on why one would even consecrate themselves to Mary as well as praying the Rosary and other various prayers to Mary and God. This consecration to Mary is simply a furthering and deepening of our devotion furthering and deepening of our devotion to and relationship with Jesus through Our Lady. If you already have an affection for Mary and talk to her often, consecration is a natural step.
