The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) encourages divorced persons who wish to marry in the Catholic Church to seek counsel about existing options that may remedy their marital situation, including the suitability of an annulment when there is no longer any hope of reconciliation of the spouses.

An annulment is a declaration by the Diocesan Tribunal (a local Catholic church court) that a marriage thought to be valid according to Church law actually fell short of at least one of the essential elements required for a binding union.

### The Divine Mercy Journey


In summary, this Feast is to be:

\*The Chaplet of Divine Mercy recited. \*"Works of mercy in word, deed, or prayer" are to be included in observance of this Feast. \*To receive Jesus' promises we must repent of our sins, be in a state of Grace through Sacramental Confession and receive Holy Communion (Diary # 429,965, 1588).

Jesus requested to St. Faustina 14 times to have this Feast & through



the listening heart of St. John Paul II, we have this special Feast. Today, ... if we desire it ... we will obtain forgiveness of sin and punishment. This EXTRAOR-DINARY Promise by Jesus is stated in the Diary #699 of St. Faustina as follows:



"My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable Mercy.

I desire that the Feast of Mercy

be a refuge and shelter for all souls, especially sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender Mercy are open.



### TOTAL CONSECRATION TO JESUS THROUGH MARY






