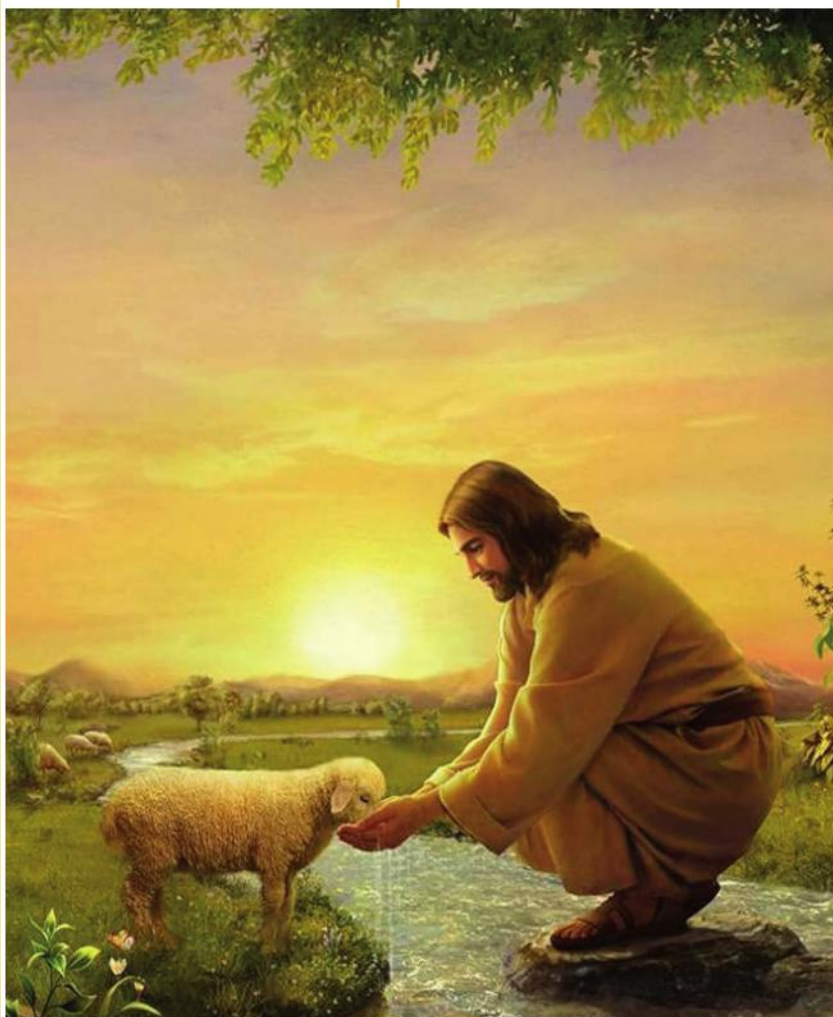

TOTAL CONSECRATION TO JESUS THROUGH MARY

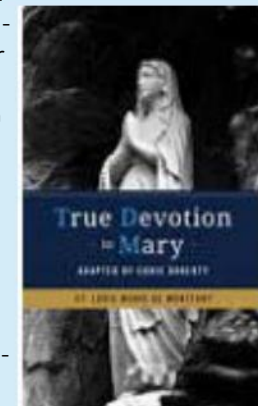

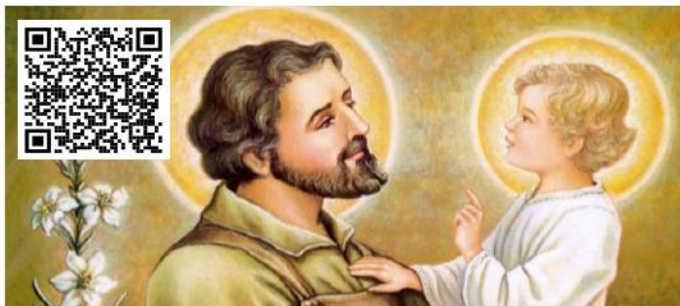

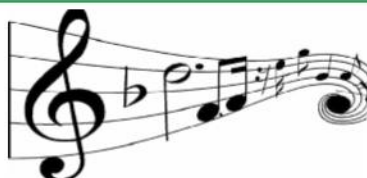
