#### PLEASE NOTE: NEW REGULATIONS FOR ST. JOSEPH'S CEMETERY

Please help keep our cemetery maintenance staff and all visitors safe by following the updated rules and regulations. These rules and regulations follow Diocesan Guidelines for Catholic Cemeteries. Some of the changes include:

• NO GLASS is allowed in the cemetery – no candles, no glass vases, no glass figurines. These will be removed.

• No plants are to be put into the ground. Plastic or non-breakable pots and containers only.

• No gravel is allowed to be placed in the cemetery and will be removed.

• Small personal items can fall to the ground, be hit by the mowers, fly up and cause injury. These items will be removed.

• Holiday decorations, flowers and plants may be placed two weeks prior to the holiday and will be removed two weeks after the holiday.

• Floral arrangements for a new burial will be removed once the flowers have faded.

• Please see our website for more information and complete updated rules and regulations for columbarium, mausoleum, and in ground burials. These are also posted in the cemetery. If you prefer a printed copy, please call our parish office, 904-268-5422





# MANDARIN FOOD BANK

The volunteers of the Mandarin Food Bank would like to share that this is our 33rd year of serving the Mandarin Community. Our population has grown over the years. We serve an average of 50 families each day that we are open - Monday, Wednesday, and Friday or 150 families each week. The summer months will be here shortly and it's a time when our donations are quite low

Our food supply quickly decreases each week since we give 5,550 non-perishable items, plus produce, frozen protein, and bakery products. In 2023, we served 8,818 families which translates to a staggering 299,846 non-perishable items. The food we give our needy families is designed to last one week. Our clients need to wait one month before returning.

We are deeply grateful for the overwhelming support we have received over the years from our St. Joseph's community. We would find it hard to function without your support. Annulments

Your parish Priests and Deacons understand the pain of those for whom divorce seemed the only recourse. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) encourages divorced persons who wish to marry in the Catholic Church to seek counsel about existing options that may remedy their marital situation, including the suitability of an annulment when there is no longer any hope of reconciliation of the spouses.

An annulment is a declaration by the Diocesan Tribunal (a local Catholic church court) that a marriage thought to be valid according to Church law actually fell short of at least one of the essential elements required for a binding union.

# **MANDARIN FOOD BANK**

Items we need during these hot summer months.

• The first would be water- (small bottles and gallon jugs). We can also use reusable ice packs, (we place these in small Styrofoam coolers that we give to homeless and families living in their cars.) Popsicles, sugar free freeze pops etc. can help take the edge off children waiting in the car with a parent.

• Condiments like catsup, mustard, and relish

• Beans of all kinds help add protein to rice, chili, and other dishes like Macaroni and cheese to make a complete meal.

- Spaghetti sauce, canned chicken, pasta
- Canned tuna, ham, noodle side dishes.

• Cream soup helps make great casseroles, soups of all kinds including Ramen.


