The Divine Mercy Journey:

is best understood and loved when we have knowledge and are acquainted with God's chosen messenger, St. Maria Faustina . From the Introduction to The Diary we read ... : To all external appearances nothing betrayed her extraordinarily rich mystical life. ... Her entire life was concentrated on constant striving for an even fuller union with God and on self-sacrificing cooperation with Jesus in the work of saving souls. "My Jesus" ... "You know from my earliest years I have wanted to become a great saint; that is to say, I have wanted to love You with a love so great that

there would be no soul who has hitherto loved You so." (Diary 1372) It is in her diary that she reveals to us the depths of her spiritual life. An attentive reading of records offer a picture of the high degree of the soul's union with God. As lavishly gifted as she was, this is what she wrote:

"Neither graces, nor revelations, nor raptures, nor gifts granted to a soul make it perfect, but rather the intimate union of the soul with God. ... My sanctity and perfection is based upon the close union of my will with the Will of God." (Diary 1107)

No. 4 Constitutional Amendment, Article 1, New Section Amendment to Limit Government Interference with Abortion
