Children's Nativity Christmas Mass

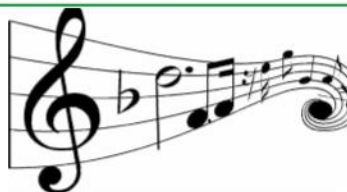
