Annulmen

Your parish Priests and Deacons understand the pain of those for whom divorce seemed the only recourse. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) encourages divorced persons who wish to marry in the Catholic Church to seek counsel about existing options that may remedy their marital situation, including the suitability of an annulment when there is no longer any hope of reconciliation of the spouses.

An annulment is a declaration by the Diocesan Tribunal (a local Catholic church court) that a marriage thought to be valid according to Church law actually fell short of at least one of the essential elements required for a binding union.

If you are scheduled to have surgery, or a medical procedure, or are in danger of death and would like to receive the sacrament of the sick, please contact the office at 904-268-5422 to make an appointment with one of our priests.

BAPTISM

If you would like to have your precious child baptized in our parish, please visit our website to fill out a baptism packet form to register for a baptism seminar. Parents

must either be registered members of our parish or present a letter of permission to have their baby baptized outside of your parish. Godparents must be confirmed, actively practicing Catholics, and at least 16 years old. Sponsor Eligibility Forms (available on



our website) for each godparent MUST be signed and sealed by the Catholic church they attend and must be submitted before a date can be chosen. If the potential sponsor has NOT been ACTIVELY registered here at St. Joseph for at least 6 months, that person will need to have their previous parish complete the Sponsor Eligibility Form.
