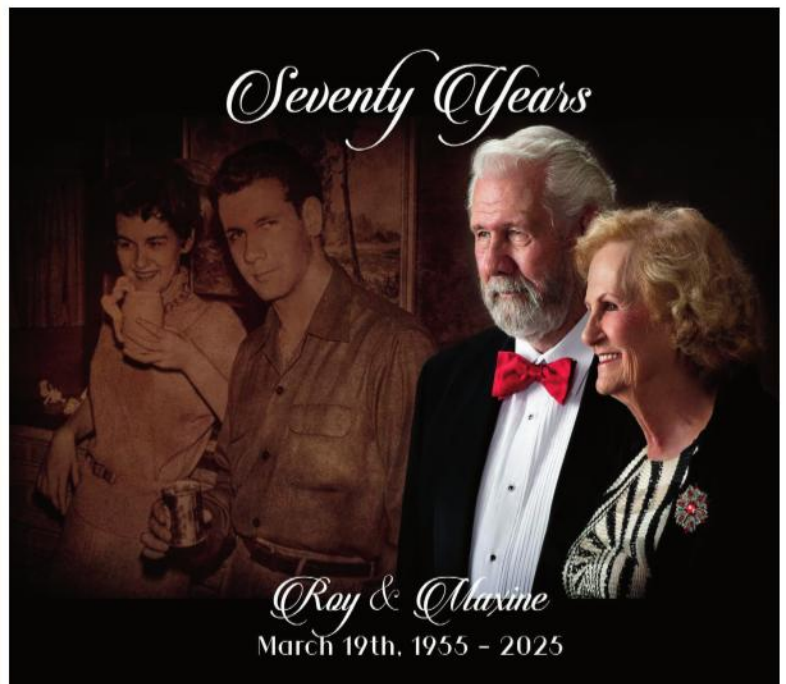

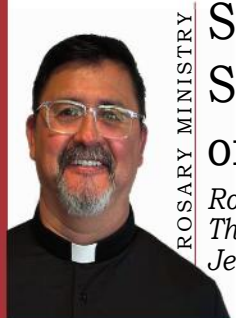

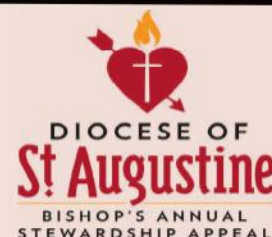

Divine Mercy Journey

Lent is a time of self examination of our beginning to the present. We ponder and review the good and bad events that we participated. Based on our evaluations, we make corrections so that the good exceed the bad in our life in the future. From our Baptism, the Holy Spirit is that quiet voice within that continually whispers in our mind and heart and guides us on the straight and narrow way. For those hidden times when we did not listen to the Holy Spirit, we have recourse to Confession for forgiveness.

The basis for His forgiveness comes from God's **SUPER DIVINE LOVE**. It is a Love that emanates from our Creator God the Father, through Jesus that supersedes all humanly conceivable understanding of ... **LOVE!** In fact, God so much wants to describe this special Love that He directs us to celebrate the Feast on an individual day, the Sunday after Easter Sunday, and call it Divine Mercy Sunday. On this day ... "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion ... shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment." (Diary 699) The Grace received is likened to a second Baptism. A perfect goal for a perfect Lent.
