Church Bus Trip to Florida State Prison for Executions

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches "...in the light of the Gospel, that 'the death penalty is inadmissible because it is an attack on the inviolability and dignity of the person', and she works with determination for its abolition worldwide." This year our state of Florida is executing prisoners at a rate of nearly 2 per month. In July, executions are scheduled for the 15th and the 31st. We plan to offer transportation on our Church Bus to the site to participate in a Prayer Service for the prisoner, their victim(s), and in opposition to this form of punishment.
