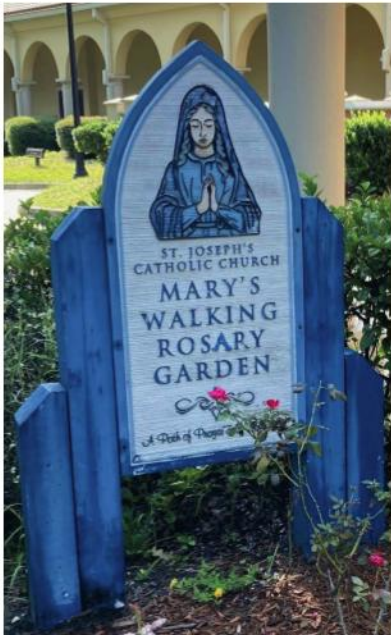

- Those who have never been baptized (Includes children aged 7 years and older who have never been baptized)
- Those who have been baptized in another Christian faith and seek to join the Catholic Church
- Those who have been baptized Catholic but have not received the remaining Sacraments of Initiation (First Holy Communion and Confirmation)

The NEW OCIA SEASON for anyone seeking baptism begins on June 29. For those who have already been baptized, OCIA classes begin on September 7. Registration before classes begin is required. All rehearsals are in the Main Church. All musicians and singers are welcome! No experience necessary.

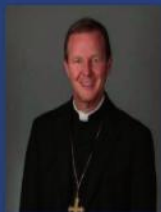
