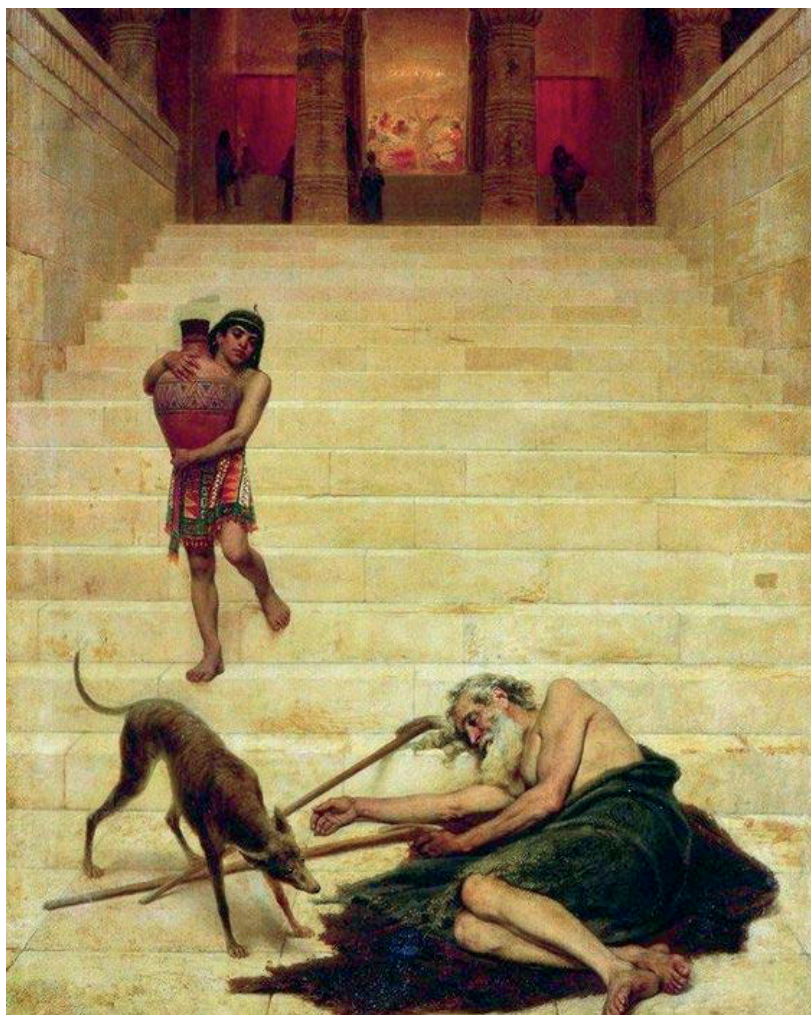

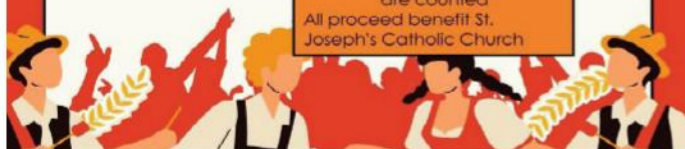

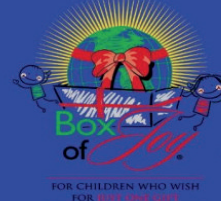
CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

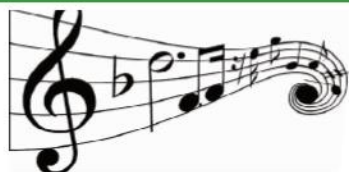

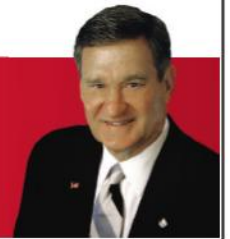
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Map showing location near St. Joseph's Catholic Church.

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
