

My name is Jessica Sizemore, and I am truly excited to serve as your Youth Minister! I'm a Jacksonville native and a graduate of San Jose Catholic School and Bishop Kenny High School. After completing my undergraduate degrees at the University of South Florida, I returned home—where God was already preparing the next chapter of my life and ministry.

My faith began to deepen during my middle school years, when my relationship with God first became personal and real. While I often credit the youth leaders who guided me, I know that the transformation I experienced was the work of the Holy Spirit; those leaders simply allowed themselves to be instruments of His grace. Youth ministry matters to me not because I believe I can change lives, but because I want to make myself available for God to work through me as a conduit, helping our young people experience a faith that is real to them. Those early formative years left a lasting mark on my heart and continue to fuel my passion for ministry today.

I have a deep love for both middle and high school students, with a special appreciation for the middle school years—knowing firsthand just how foundational that stage can be in forming a lasting faith.

Through prayer and hands-on ministry with teens, I began to sense a clear and persistent call to serve the young Church more intentionally. That call led me to pursue a Master of Arts in Catechesis and Evangelization at Franciscan University of Steubenville, which I expect to complete this year.

St. Joseph's Catholic Church has a vibrant and well-established youth program, and I am honored to step into a community already so alive in faith.

My desire is to continue leading our youth closer to Christ while, over time, creating even more opportunities for them to grow spiritually, build authentic community, and encounter the Lord in deeper ways.

I believe that our young people are not simply the "Church of tomorrow," but the Church of today. I am truly excited to get to know our students and their families and to walk together as we grow closer to Christ.
