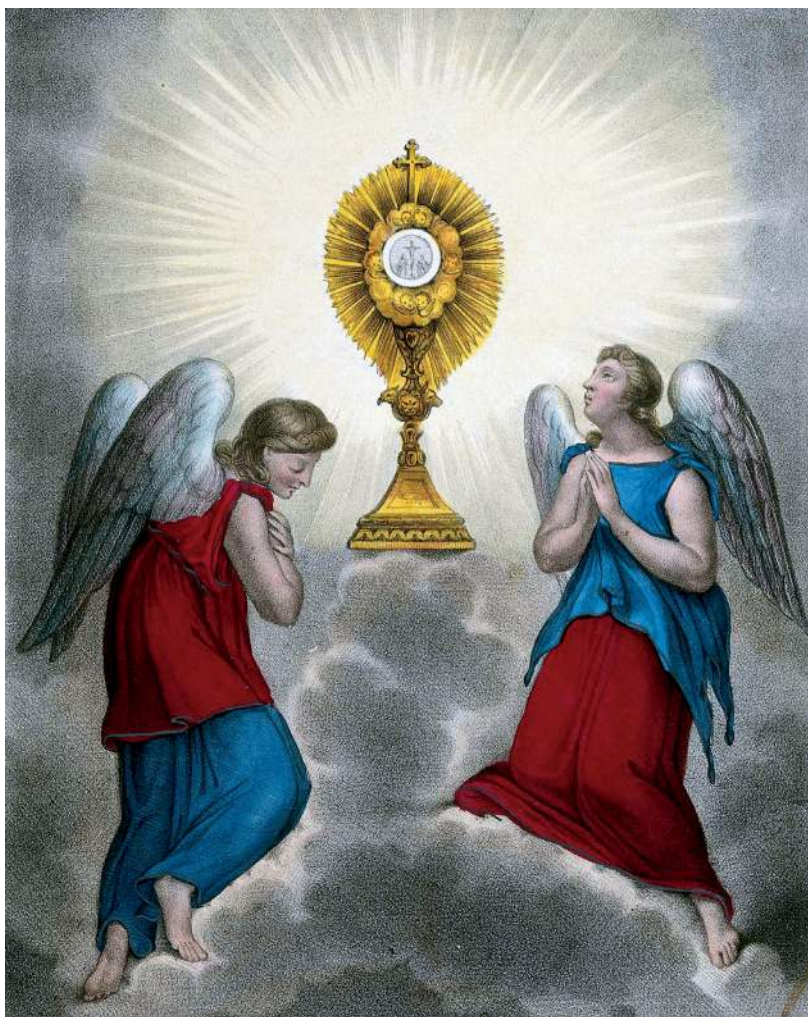

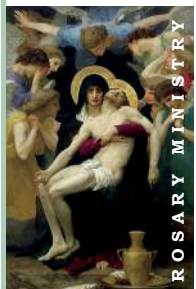

A NEW OCIA SEASON IS BEGINNING

OCIA is a faith journey by which inquirers prepare to become Catholic or finish their initiation into the Catholic Church. The Sacraments of Initiation are Baptism, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion. OCIA is the process of discerning one's readiness for this commitment.

The OCIA process is for:

- Those who have never been baptized (Includes children aged 7 years and older who have never been baptized)
- Those who have been baptized in another Christian faith and seek to join the Catholic Church
- Those who have been baptized Catholic but have not received the remaining Sacraments of Initiation (Confirmation and First Holy Communion)
- Never Baptized? (Ages 15 years and up)
- Monthly sessions begin April 26, 2026.
- Children who have never been baptized? (Ages 7-14 years)
- Monthly sessions begin Thursday, April 30, 2026, from 6:30-8:00 p.m.
- A parent is required to attend each session.
- Sacramental preparation for children is a minimum of two years.

Previously Baptized?

Sessions will begin August 30, 2026.

WALKING WITH PURPOSE:

Walking with Purpose is a nonprofit Catholic women's ministry founded 18 years ago by Lisa Brenninkmeyer. She and her team write fresh, relevant Catholic Bible studies that help adult women to grow closer to Christ as they lean on truths found in Scripture to create joy-filled lives. No walking is required!

These studies are unique in that they offer solutions found in the Bible that can be applied to our everyday lives. They vary in length and depth to meet the needs of different women. Some studies are 22 weeks and others as short as 6 weeks long.

St Joseph's WWP meetings will resume in late August 2026. There will be an Open House followed by weekly sessions of reading, reflecting and sharing within a small group setting. The ladies meet on Thursday evenings from 7:00pm until 8:30pm.

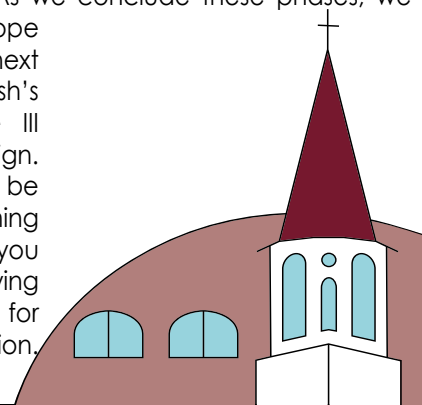
