FIGHTING ABORTION



Vote NO on 4! HE did it – we did it! The election on November 5 resulted in a couple of wins for the Pro-Life movement. The good Lord used us parishioners as His instruments to educate enough people to defeat the extreme pro-abortion Amendment 4. Our prayers, presentations, and publicity for LIFE were not in vain. We give thanks as we prepare for this Thanksgiving Holiday. We thank Bishop Pohlmeier and Father Ruchinski for their leadership on this effort. Special recognition also to those who were out canvassing Mandarin as well as Duval, Clay, and St John's counties distributing informational door hangers identifying the deceptive language and truth about the Amendment. Sebastian, Pat, Laura, George, Robert, Cindy, Lucy, Jean, Gianna, Savannah, Lana, Carron, Russ, Diane, the Family For LIFE group, and many other faithful Catholics and Christians of various denominations disseminated approximately 200,000 door hangers over the past 5 months. And although we do not endorse any political candidate or party for election, the election results prevented (temporarily) a certain candidate/party from enshrining a "right to abortion" into Federal Law using any means necessary (i.e. eliminating the filibuster).* However, we only slowed the advancement of the culture of death by a narrow margin. Results showed Florida's proposed Amendment 4 received 57% "Yes" votes (it needed 60% to pass). Seven of the ten abortion initiatives in various states passed, with Florida being one of just three states to uphold abortion limitations. This shows we have much work to do to change hearts and minds on the sanctity of life from conception to natural death. Sadly, many poorly catechized Catholics were not on the side of Life in this election. We pray for the Holy Spirit to touch their hearts, that they come to see the truth, repent, and promote a culture of Life. We cannot rest, we must continue proclaiming the Gospel of Life.

Praying to End Abortion at Planned Parenthood



Our Fall **40 Days for Life** campaign ran from **Sept 25 - Nov 3.** Our vigil site was the Planned Parenthood at 5978 Powers Avenue. Led by our Respect Life Co-coordinator Savannah O'Brien, prayer pals advocated for the unborn. Florida's Heartbeat Protection Act protects most innocent unborn human beings in their mothers' wombs after 6 weeks. All abortions before 6 weeks are legal, and exemptions for victims of rape, incest, and human trafficking legalize abortion up to 15 weeks. In cases when the life of the mother is at risk there are no restrictions. So, we continue to have these vigils. Our next campaign will be during Lent 2025.

Our First Saturdays' Church Bus trip to Planned Parenthood following the 8:00am Mass has been a success for the past 24 months. Come out and join us! We depart around 8:45am from the Historic Church parking lot and return to the same place around 10:30am. Our next trip is December 7. We supply signs but bring your own Rosary. You don't have to climb aboard the bus, you can drive yourself and meet us at Planned Parenthood (5978 Powers Ave). The Holy Spirit has moved some of our parishioners to stand as witnesses, praying for the most vulnerable. Since our last Communiqué I witnessed 52 hours over a period of 29 days (several of those days I stood uncomfortably alone, so please get the word out to pro-life people to join me especially on weekdays). I observed 264 "customers" enter, received 3428 positive and 171 negative reactions from passersby, and passed out 15 "Blessing Bags" containing pro-life information. We also witnessed 1 firm SAVE during this time. Thank you Lucy, Normand, Savannah, Pat, Alan, Lana, Marilyn, Melissa, Alpha, Pauline, both Ricks, Barb, Bernadette, Fran, Mary Jane, Carol, Bill, Nicole, David, Patty, Joyce, Randy, George, Luis, Carron, Russ, Cindy, Filipe, Ellen, Celia, Isabella, Mathew, Karen, Joan, MaryAnn, Maribel, Tony, Butch, Abby, Cassandra, Annette, Leah, Paul, Bill, Don, and anyone else I may have missed who came out to stand up for the unborn at any of the 3 abortion clinics in Jacksonville. I invite, encourage, and pray that all St Joseph pro-lifers will do the same, as their circumstances permit. We have difficulty maintaining a pro-life presence on the sidewalk at Planned Parenthood during weekday hours. Young people on the sidewalk are a great visual and a resource to effectively communicate with "customers" who are members of the same generation.
