"Decline to Sign" Initiative/Pro-Abortion Amendment Status

Our effort to prevent Pro-Abortion forces to get enough signatures to place a proposed abortion amendment on the November 2024 ballot failed. The abortion "rights" group Floridians Protecting Freedom collected 1.5 million signatures as of January to place the measure on the general election ballot this November. However, Florida Attorney General Ashley Moody asked the state Supreme Court to review the wording of the amendment and ballot summary, saying that the wording of the measure is possibly confusing to voters. On February 7 the Florida Supreme Court heard a challenge by the Florida Attorney General to the language of the proposed amendment. The proposed amendment, if allowed by the Florida Supreme Court would be presented like this...

Ballot Title: Amendment to Limit Government Interference with Abortion

Ballot Language: No law shall prohibit, penalize, delay, or restrict abortion before viability or when necessary to protect the patient's health, as determined by the patient's healthcare provider. This amendment does not change the Legislature's constitutional authority to require notification to a parent or guardian before a minor has an abortion.

The amendment obviously will get support from "Pro-Choice" voters, but the language contains verbiage that attempts to also draw conservative voters/votes (even pro-life ones) with phrases like "*No law shall prohibit…*" and "*This amendment does not change the* Legislature's constitutional *authority to require notification to a parent or guardian.*" In fact, the amendment would legalize full-term abortion in Florida. There would be no protection for the unborn baby. It would allow aborting a baby capable of feeling pain and *eliminate parental consent and healthcare regulations*. And, under Florida law "*healthcare provider*" *is not limited to medical doctors,* so an employee of an abortion clinic (for example, the receptionist at Planned Parenthood) would be able to approve late-term abortions. It also *permits partial-birth abortions*. This would be disastrous if the language is approved and voted on as is. Approval of the amendment would require 60% of the vote to pass. Please pray for the court to disallow the proposed amendment language. The court will have to rule on the language prior to April 1, the deadline for proposals to be included on the ballots. If pro-abortion forces are ultimately successful in getting this abortion amendment on the ballot, it is vital that we pray, fast, and VOTE against it and for LIFE! Educate your friends and families.

Interment of Precious Ones

We Catholics have a responsibility to perform corporal works of mercy, which include burying the dead. We have several options to fulfill this obligation for the respectful interment of Precious Ones (the loss of the unborn due to miscarriage, stillbirth, or abortion).



Precious Ones Baby Mausoleum

A diocesan campaign is underway to build a mausoleum for unborn children lost through miscarriage and early infant death in an area of San Lorenzo cemetery in St. Augustine. Precious Ones will be interred at no cost to their families. There will be a garden and a bench for families visiting, and baby and family names may be printed on paver bricks (for \$150). DONATIONS ARE WELCOME to help families deal with the loss of their Precious Ones! Precious Ones burial swaddles and outfits are also available free of charge by contacting the Diocese Office of Human Life and Dignity at (904) 262-3200, ext. 159. Our St Joseph Human Life & Dignity Ministry will contribute \$25 (possibly more with donations) to the family to offset the cost of the Memorial Paver Brick for each Precious One lost.

Construction has begun and is currently paused awaiting delivery of the foundation slab, projected to be in late March or early April. Following delivery, completion of the mausoleum should only be a matter of weeks. Until completion of the Mausoleum, an arrangement has been made with 2 funeral homes to keep remains until their interment. Precious Ones will be buried in a common grave (vault). Each vault will be labelled with the name of a Saint, while the Memorial Paver Bricks can be personalized with Precious Ones' names.

St Joseph's Catholic Cemetery



Families who wish to keep the remains of their Precious Ones locally in our Cemetery can do so. The remains are kept in a common vault (cost is \$500). On the Western face of the Mausoleum in the upper right side is the vault for the unborn. Records are kept of the babies' names and dates. Our St Joseph Human Life Dignity Ministry will contribute \$25 (possibly more with donations) to the family to offset the cost of the interment for each Precious One lost.



Memorial to the Unborn



Parents who didn't have the opportunity to keep the remains of their Precious Ones for interment still have a place in our cemetery to pray for their lost loved ones. The Monument to the Unborn was provided by our Knights of Columbus and is located on the Eastern side of the Cemetery.

Our First Saturdays' Church Bus trip to Planned Parenthood following the 8:00am mass has been successfully run for the past 13 months. Come out and join us! The Bus departs around 8:45am from the Historic Church parking lot and returns around 10:30am. We supply Pro-life signs but bring your own Rosary. You don't have to ride the bus; you can drive yourself and meet us at Planned Parenthood (5978 Powers Ave). However, the parking situation is a bit uncertain. The sale of the Latino Plaza next door to Planned Parenthood apparently did not go through, so the chains have been removed and that convenient parking area is "open." However, a call to the Police from an individual claiming to be the "owner" of the building resulted in us being directed to move our vehicles or risk them being towed. We suspect that the call was a hoax, as the name of the caller was not the owner identified on county property records. We are trying to resolve this issue, and Pro-Life Prayer Pals are being warned that parking in this area is at your own risk until we resolve this situation permanently. The map shows the alternative parking areas. Since our last Communiqué I witnessed 64 hours over a period of 33 days. We observed 467 "customers" enter, had 2 firm SAVES and 1 potential SAVES, received 3170 positive and 195 negative reactions from passersby, and passed out 29 pro-life informational handouts.
