April 1 Good News / Bad News Rulings

The Good News. The Florida Supreme Court ruled that the Florida State Constitution does not include a "right" to an abortion and upheld the 15-week ban protecting innocent preborn humans from abortion from that point until birth (with some exceptions). As a result, the 6-week ban that the legislature passed and the governor signed into law in 2022 will go into effect on May 1 protecting more babies in the womb! At least until November. And now...

The Bad News. The same Florida Supreme Court ruled that the following misleading ballot language proposed by pro-abortion forces (the ACLU and Planned Parenthood) could be included on the November 2024 ballot...

If successful, this would create a "right" to abortion in the Florida Constitution, and no legislation, past or future, could overturn this so-called "right." Mothers could legally abort their unborn children for any reason up to the point of "viability" and until birth if a "healthcare provider" determines it necessary to protect the mother's "health." The wording is unclear and misleading. For example, the term "viability" is not defined, and "heathcare provider" isn't limited to a physician (could be a physician assistant and FL Statute 440.13 even states the term includes a "health care facility"). The protection of the patient's "health" is not clearly defined (doesn't mean a lifethreatening condition). The Amendment would also eliminate the requirement for parental or guardian consent before a minor has an abortion (it would only require notification). In May 2024 the protections for pre-borns at 6-weeks up until birth go into effect. This Amendment would eliminate all those protections and make Florida a late-term abortion destination. All 3 women justices on the Florida Supreme Court ruled the ballot summary misleading and should have been rejected. Unfortunately, the 4 male justices disagreed and, as the majority, let the language stand. The language "...Limit Government Interference..." is purposely crafted to mislead and attract prolife conservative, libertarian, republican and independent voters with a distrust of big government. Pro-abortion forces realize they can't get the needed 60% without drawing support from this population. Both Pro-life and Pro-choice voters of all political persuasions should vote "NO" on this extreme, barbaric, abortion amendment as it goes beyond what most voters would support. The scientific, moral, and religious truth is that every preborn child, from the moment of conception, is a human being with a God-given right to life. The truth is that abortion terminates an innocent human life (it's murder). Please pass the word, educate, and encourage all those you have influence with to vote "NO" on 4 in November.



Fetal Models & Video Aids

They show human development in the womb at 12-weeks, 16-weeks, 22-weeks, and 26-weeks to help to convey the humanity of the unborn. These models have started making the rounds at various ministry events such as the TMIY group, CRHP retreat, and the Feast of the Annunciation Mass at A Women's Choice of Jacksonville (see details below). Praying to end Abortion at Planned Parenthood



Our First Saturdays' Prayer Pilgrimage Church Bus trip to Planned Parenthood following the 8:00am mass has been successfully run for the past 17 months. Come out and join us! The Bus departs around 8:45am from the Historic Church parking lot and returns to the same place around 10:30am. We supply Pro-life signs but bring your own Rosary. You don't have to climb aboard the bus, you can drive yourself and meet us at Planned Parenthood (5978 Powers Ave). The Holy Spirit has moved some of our parishioners to stand as witnesses, praying for the most vulnerable. Since our last Communiqué I witnessed 60 hours over a period of 34 days (several of those days I stood uncomfortably alone, so please get the word out to pro-life people to join me especially on weekdays). We observed 372 "customers" enter, received 3069 positive and 189 negative reactions from passersby, and passed out 20 "Blessing Bags" containing pro-life information.
